

Festivals & Holidays

- Full moon days (poya days) are public holidays in Sri Lanka. Here, most shops are closed and
 most restaurants and bars do not offer alcohol. On beaches, it can be a bit crowded on these
 days, as many locals go on holiday to the sea.
- The probably most spectacular festival in Sri Lanka is the Kandy-Esala-Perehera Festival, which takes place every year for 10 days in August (2016 from 8.8 to 18.8.). The magnificent and colorful festive procession, which takes place every evening and is accompanied by adorned elephants, is unrivaled all over the world. But also many smaller Perehera parades and festivals, which are regularly held in all parts of the country, are very nice to look at and give a good insight into the cultural customs of the locals.
