

WINTER GEAR RENTAL INFORMATION

Salmon Berry Tours offers high-quality, cold-weather gear rentals for the convenience of our package tour clients. Please look over the below options, and let us know if you would like to add one or more to your package.

First though: Do you need rental gear?

Salmon Berry Tours has many winter tour options and full tour packages. Some tours do not require extended periods outdoors. Other DO require a lot of time outdoors. Some activities are "colder" than others. Some activities have gear provided as part of the tour. We would be happy to go over your package with you, and help you decide whether you need gear or not. We would also be happy to discuss what you already have, and whether your current gear is appropriate for the activities you have booked. Please don't be afraid to ask us these questions! We are here at your service!

FAQ's that might help you decide:

Question: "I heard Salmon Berry has complimentary cold weather gear for day tours. Do I still need rentals?"

Answer: Salmon Berry has a limited lending closet, on a first come first served basis, for Anchorage-based tours only. It is a collection of used items that have been donated to us over the years. Sizes, condition, and brands vary. These items are available for borrowing for a day trip only, and will be brought along by the tour guide as requested, if available. The guide will collect the items at the end of the tour. If you would like more consistently sized, higher quality items, that you can keep for the duration of your trip, rentals are the way to go. Loaner gear does NOT have guaranteed availability!

Question: "Why are some items for purchase and not available for rent?"

Answer: All of our rental items are cleaned after each rental. However, long-underwear items and face coverings are not commonly desired after use by another person. Layman's terms: people don't like to think that they are wearing someone else's previously worn long underwear!

Question: "Why don't you rent Canada Goose Down parkas?"

Answer: Most of our tours and adventures are not Expedition - Level excursions. Canada Goose Down parkas, though amazing, are actually too heavy for our purposes. On expeditions that require that level of expedition gear, these type of parkas are provided and included in the expedition package. Another benefit of our Kavik Down Parka is that it is more flexible and lightweight than the Canada Goose Down parkas, for maneuverability.



Rental packs need to be picked up at the Salmon Berry Tours office in Anchorage, Alaska, or Fairbanks by special request, and returned to this location at the end of your trip (see next paragraph for exceptions). Each guest, or party, will fill out a rental agreement, pay the entire rental fee, and Salmon Berry Tours will keep your card on file for any missing or damaged items at the end of the rental period. No pro-rated days are accepted. Rental will be counted in full days from the day you pick up the pack to the day you return the pack. The rental agreement specifies the detailed terms of the rental.

Please reserve and pay for your rentals 60 days in advance to guarantee exact sizing. If you are within that time frame, just call or email us and we will check on availability.

Note for Itineraries starting or ending in Fairbanks: Many of our packages begin in Anchorage and end in Fairbanks, or vice versa. You may return your rental gear in Fairbanks if you have chosen the package ending there. You may do this by leaving the complete gear bag with the front desk of the hotel or with your tour guide on your last day. If your package begins in Fairbanks, and you rented gear from us in advance, your gear bags will be waiting for you at the front desk of the hotel, so please ask for them when you check in.

Rental gear comes with a duffel bag to carry your items, and will contain a list of the items that belong with the bag. When you return the bag, our representative will verify that all items have been returned in the bag, and are in good condition (normal wear and tear accepted). Please remember to remove any purchased items that you do not intend to turn back into us!

The "Optional Purchase Pack", also described below, need not be returned to Salmon Berry. This is a straight purchase, and will be lovingly acquired by Salmon Berry's team, on your behalf, in your requested sizes (see additional pages for sizing charts). You can then use these items and take them home with you, or leave them here if you please, but there is no rental option on these items.

Note on Allergies: if you have allergies to any sort of fibers or animals, please research the brands of clothing listed in these packs, and ensure that you will not have an allergic reaction. Our travel specialists are not qualified or authorized to give advice regarding allergens in clothing. If you do have allergies, we recommend buying and bringing your own gear.

Note on Sizing: The sizing charts listed in the rest of this document are according to manufacturer. However, we have discovered that you need to size up for the snowpants and parka. You will not be naked underneath! You need room for lots of layers, so please choose a larger size than you think you need!



CLOTHING PACKAGE PRICING:

Outerwear Winter Gear Pack rental: \$50/day

- Kavik Talkeetna Down Parka with hood (sizes avail: Men's S-2XL)
- Snow pants (sizes avail: S-3XL, men's or women's)
- Full-hand heavy winter mittens, black
- Pack boot rated to -40F or better (almost any size available)
- Canvas 38" heavy duty duffel with carrying strap

*Note: boot brands we carry include Baffin, Snogoose, Alpha Pac, Sorrel. Your size needs will determine which brand you will receive. Don't worry - we chose them well!

*Boot size notes: Some of our boots only come in men's sizes. However, we will convert to a women's size where needed. The fit will not be different if you receive a men's boot, rather than a women's boot. When sending your shoe size, please keep in mind that you do not want boots to be tight - so if you barely squeeze into a size when wearing your dress shoes, please request the next size up. There are no half sizes. Too big is better than snug!

CLOTHING DESCRIPTIONS, SIZES AND MATERIALS:

Quick Tip: Go a size larger for parka and snowpants!

KAVIK MEN'S TALKEETNA DOWN PARKA

Features:

- Durable, water resistant rip stop nylon shell

This parka reaches to the thighs on most people, for added warmth. Do not worry too much about the "back length" measurement on this chart. It will not be too short. The most important measurements, to determine in advance your best size, is your chest circumference around the largest point, and your sleeve length from the base of your neck to your wrist. Those two measurements should help you choose an appropriate size from the chart below. A diagram is also included below, to help you understand what these measurements mean.


