

Itinerary:

Day 1 AIRPORT / NEGOMBO / SIGIRIYA

At arrival, welcomed & assisted at the airport then leave to Sigiriya. En-route visit Negombo. The population in Negombo is largely Roman Catholic by faith, with large structured churches down almost every street. The sea and the catamarans are the backdrop to the Negombo scenery. At P.M. pay a visit to Sigiriya located in the North-Central part of Sri Lanka which preserves the architectural tradition of the country. The town is famous for its rock fortress, gardens and sanctuary. Sigiriya has spectacular importance in Sri Lanka. An ancient palace complex, erected during the reign of King Kashyapa, which has been declared by UNESCO as a world heritage site. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 2 POLONNARUWA / MEDIRIGIRIYA

After breakfast get ready for an excursion in Polonnaruwa, the second ancient capital city for three centuries. It is one of the most interesting places in Sri Lanka with many well preserved ruins of palaces and monasteries. You can then visit Medirigiriya early in the evening. It is optional to try elephant back riding in the jungle safari for 01h30 minutes but (customers must make payment direct.) Return back to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3 DAMBULLA / NALANDA GEDIGE / MATALE / KANDY

After breakfast leave for Kandy, en-route visit Dambulla. In Sri Lankan history the Dambulla cave complex dates back to 3rd and 2nd centuries B.C. The cave structure was popular even before the construction of the complex began, as one of the largest monasteries of Sri Lanka. The Dambulla cave temples have been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. It is also known for bird watching. You can visit Nalanda Gedige the Abu Simbel of Sri Lanka. Nalanda Gedige is one of a number of remarkable archaeological sites in Sri Lanka and then visit a spice garden & a batik factory in Matale. On the way to Kandy the center of the traditional arts in Sri Lanka visit the city of Kandy. The most famous landmark of Kandy is its lake, in the center of the city. You can visit the Kandy museum. Late in the evening view the Kandyan cultural performance & visit the temple of the sacred tooth relic of Buddha. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 4 KANDY / PERADENIYA / PINNAWALA / NUWARA ELIYA

After breakfast visit the royal botanical gardens of Peradeniya which is well known for its large variety of plants. The garden is best known for its collection of orchids which are the largest in Asia. After the visit to the garden you can visit the Pinnawela elephant orphanage. The orphanage was established to feed, nurse & house young elephants abandoned by their mothers. During the drought period, the young ones often fall into pits and ravines in their quest for water. At P.M. leave for Nuwara Eliya the center of the hill country. En-route visit a tea plantation and witness the manufacture of the world famous **Ceylon tea**. Gregory Lake is one of the most attractive/scenic locations in Nuwara Eliya and Shanthipura (the city view point). Spend the evening walking in the cool climate. Arrive at the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 5 NUWARA ELIYA / KITULGALA / COLOMBO

After breakfast leave for Colombo through misty mountain routes. You can view waterfalls as well as landscapes with tea plantations and other vegetation via Kitulgala. Kitulgala was the filming location of World War II movie "The Bridge on the River Kwai" based on the novel by French writer Pierre Boulle.

Day 6 COLOMBO / AIRPORT

After breakfast get ready for a transfer to the airport in order for departure. The rooms are available untill 12h00 in the afternoon.
