DETAIL ITINERARY SAIGON – HOIAN – HANOI – HALONG BAY - HANOI 13 DAYS / 12 NIGHTS

Day 01 (12 JUL'19): ARRIVAL - SAIGON

Upon your arrival @ PR597/ ETA 14:30, the local guide will meet and transfer to your hotel in the center of the town. Check in and free.

Overnight at LE DUY HOTEL 3*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 02 (13 JUL'19): MEKONG DELTA – FULL DAY TOUR (Breakfast, Lunch)

Start the day tour by exploring the fascinating Mekong Delta. By travelling along Vietnam's most important highway you will pass through seemingly endless paddy fields. At My Tho you will visit the ancient Vinh Trang pagoda. Next, a motorized sampan will take you on a fascinating tour through the vast estuary of the Mekong Delta. All daily life and agricultural activities are centered on the countless branches of the river. Because of its abundance of rice fields and water, this region is called the Rice Bowl of Vietnam. Visit a local fruit orchard on one of the countless islands.

Overnight at LE DUY HOTEL 3*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 03 (14 JUL'19): SAIGON- FULL DAY CITY TOUR (Breakfast, Lunch)

See the city's major sights on this essential full day tour. Start at the elegant Historical Museum and trace the country's history from the ancient Dong Son period until recent time. En route, see the twin-spired Notre Dame Cathedral and the City Hall. Explore the old Presidential Palace with its remarkable network of underground bunkers. Venture through bustling Chinatown, locally known as Cholon, with its colourful atmosphere and mysterious temples. Visit the lively Thien Hao Pagoda, with the enormous burning incense-coils that never fail to impress. After lunch at a local restaurant, continue to visit the War Remnants Museum. The Museum contains fascinating remnants and photographs of the Vietnam War including US armored vehicles, artillery pieces, bombs and infantry weapons. Continue on to the Art Museum which houses many interesting collections and revolutionary art. Last stop will be the colorful Ben Thanh Market (Cho Ben Thanh Market); see skillful artisans at work in a Lacquer-ware factory, visit art galleries, and indulge in the splendors of a Vietnamese Silk Shop. Stroll along the many tantalizing shops of Dong Khoi Street, once known as Rue Catinat, the boulevard where the high society flocked and shopped in colonial times. Shop for bargains and discover your bargaining power and come away with unusual items that will always remind you of this exciting day.

Overnight at LE DUY HOTEL 3*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 4 (15 JUL'1): SAIGON- DANANG/HOIAN (Breakfast)

Breakfast at hotel. Free until the pick-up to airport for flight to Danang @VN126 SGNDAD 1300/1420 (subject to change). Upon your arrival, local guide will meet you and transfer to hotel in Hoian.

Overnight at River Beach Resort 4*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 5-7 (16-18 JUL'19): HOIAN (Breakfast)

Free at your leisure.

Day 8 (19 JUL'19): HOIAN/ DANANG - HANOI (Breakfast)

Breakfast at hotel. Free until the pick-up to airport for flight to Hanoi @VN172 DADHAN 1300/1420 (subject to change). Upon your arrival, local guide will meet you and transfer to hotel in Hanoi.



Overnight at LENID HOTEL 3*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 9 (20 JUL'19): HANOI – FULL DAY CITY TOUR (Breakfast, Lunch)

Today, you will visit the cities main historical sites including a photo stop outside Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and a visit to Ho Chi Minh's house, where he preferred to live simply, which are splendid reminders of the great man who once led this country. Our next stop is the Temple of Literature, the first university of Vietnam. In the afternoon, you will visit the Ethnology Museum, which focuses on the 54 officially recognized groups in Vietnam. This will be followed by an informative group lecture on ethnic textile and dyeing techniques. Then, take a walking tour into narrow streets of the Old Quarter through Silk Street, Rice Street, Paper Street, Lacquer Ware Street, and Jewelry Street.... You will have an opportunity to shop for bargains and discover your bargaining power and come away with unusual items that will always remind you of this exciting afternoon.

Overnight at LENID HOTEL 3*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 10 (21 JUL'19): HANOI - HALONG (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

This morning you are collected at around 8:00 by our local guide for the three-hour-drive to Halong Bay. En route there will be a short stop at the Sao Do centre run for and by handicapped children. On your arrival in Halong Bay, transfer by boat to the wonderful junk-style ship. Once settled in, you start your cruise around the majestic Halong Bay, while enjoying a delicious lunch. Drinks are available for sale on board. After lunch, you have the chance to explore some of the limestone caves dotted around the bay. Then, the captain will find a secluded spot where you can swim in the clear water of the bay, soak up the sun on the top deck. In the evening, the cook prepares a sumptuous meal as the boat weighs anchor in the heart of the bay. For those who are interested, there is the opportunity to do some night fishing. Overnight on board.

Overnight at ORIENTAL SAILS 3*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 11 (22 JUL'19): HALONG BAY (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Rising to the tranquil beauty of the bay you have time for an early morning swim followed by breakfast. This morning you continue to cruise around the bay to find more secluded areas to either swim or kayak (kayaking at your own expense). Continue the cruise through thousands of limestone islands & islets. You will have the chance to discover one of the world's most wonderful locations and experience the most spectacular landscapes that not to be missed. Stop for a visit at Surprise Cave, Cua Van Fishing Village. Drop anchor at Fairy Cave Area for swimming and stay overnight.

Overnight at ORIENTAL SAILS 3*, Deluxe room or similar.

Day 12 (23 JUL'19): HALONG - HANOI (Brunch)

This morning, you will keep on cruising on the bay until 10:30 and then return to the pier. After disembark the junk, the waiting vehicle will meet and transfer you back to Hanoi, the journey of about 3.5 hours and you will arrive in Hanoi approx. 15:30

Note(s):

- You can leave your main luggage in Hanoi, so just take a small bag with a change of clothes and essential travel items
- The cruise itinerary is subject to change without prior notice, upon the weather condition.
- The cruise is based on sharing junk with seat-in-coach transfers.

Day 13 (24 JUL'19): HANOI – DEPARTURE (Breakfast)

Today, you are free at leisure until airport transfer out to take your flight @PR596/ETD 1:45AM on 25 Jul'19.
