**DAY 01 – 31 DEC 19 – ARRIVAL JAIPUR**

Welcome to Jaipur, the capital city of Rajasthan. Our representative will receive you at the airport and transfer you to the hotel (Standard Check in time is 1400 Hrs). Relax and spend rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Jaipur.

**DAY 02 – 01 JAN 20 – JAIPUR SIGHTSEEING**

Morning after breakfast at your hotel you will be taken to explore the Pink City with an excursion to Amber Fort, situated just outside the city, enjoy the experience of ride on elephant back to and from the top of the hill on which the fort is situated. Afternoon sightseeing tour of City Palace in the heart of Jaipur is known for its blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. Not far away is the Central Museum. Jantar Mantar is the largest of the five observatories built by Sawai Jai Singh. The Hawa Mahal or the Palace of Winds was constructed for the royal ladies to watch the royal processions without being seen, all monuments are located in the vicinity of City Palace Complex of Jaipur. Later late afternoon is kept free to visit the famous Markets of Textiles, Gems, Carpets, and handicrafts. Jaipur is an ideal place for buying souvenirs. Overnight stay at hotel.

**DAY 03 – 02 JAN 20 – IN JAIPUR**

After breakfast, full day free for shopping and for leisure activities. Overnight stay at hotel.

**DAY 04 – 03 JAN 20 – JAIPUR – RANTHAMBORE**

**BY: SURFACE (190 KMS / 04 HRS)**

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Ranthambore. Upon arrival check in to hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at resort.





#### **DAY 05 – 04 JAN 20 – RANTHAMBORE SAFARIS**

Morning proceed to take the Jungle Safari by open Canter/Jeep accompanied by an expert naturalist to explore Ranthambore wildlife Sanctuary, one of the best places in India to see a tiger in its natural habitat. In the dry season tigers can be seen near the watering holes and are clearly visible in the dry forest. Return to the hotel for a lunch. Later visit Ranthambore Fort looking the National Park and Jogi Mahal. Also visit the famous Temple of Ganesha in the Fort. Dinner and overnight stay at resort.

#### **DAY 06 – 05 JAN 20 – RANTHAMBORE – AGRA      BY: SURFACE (260 KMS / 06 HRS)**

After breakfast, you'll be transferred to Agra en-route visiting **Fatehpur Sikri** (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). Built in the 16th century, this ancient fortified city was once the capital of the Mughal Empire. Built preferably with red sandstone, the architecture of the city reflects both Hindu and Muslim forms of domestic architecture, popular during that time. It can be accessed through five gates including Buland Darwaza, and features many important buildings like the Jama Masjid, Tomb of Salim Chisti, Diwan-i-Aam, Diwan-i-Khas, and Panch Mahal among others. Upon arrival in Agra, check into the hotel and freshen up. Later proceed to visit the massive Agra Fort (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), an elegant building that reflects a perfect fusion of the Hindu and Central Asian architectural styles with massive courtyards, mosques & private chambers. A historical fort, it served as the main residence of the emperors of the Mughal Dynasty until 1638, when the capital was shifted from Agra to Delhi. In the evening visit Mehtab Bagh. Overnight stay at hotel.

#### **DAY 07 – 06 JAN 20 – AGRA – DELHI**

**BY: SURFACE (260 KMS / 06 HRS)**

Early morning proceeds to visit Taj Mahal an unmatched beauty, the Taj Mahal is one of the seven wonders in the world. Built as a tomb for his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal by Shah Jahan, the Taj depicts mute tales of the profound love story between the emperor and his beloved wife. *(Note: Taj Mahal will be closed on every Friday)*

Later return back to hotel for breakfast. After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Delhi. Upon arrival check in to hotel. Evening free at leisure. Overnight stay at hotel.





#### DAY 08 – 07 JAN 20 – DELHI SIGHTSEEING

Have breakfast and then set out for Delhi city sightseeing tour. You'll first go for Old Delhi sightseeing, starting with *Jama Masjid*, the country's largest mosque. Completed in 1656 AD, the mosque features three gates, four towers and two towering minarets. Constructed with strips of red sandstone and white marble, the mosque's courtyard is capable of holding 25,000 devotees at once. The iconic mosque is one of the last monuments built under Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan. Next, visit Old Delhi's oldest and biggest market *Chandni Chowk*. Later, enjoy a *rickshaw ride* from Fatehpuri Masjid to the impressive red sandstone monument of *Red Fort*, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here, our driver will pick you up and drive you to *Raj Ghat*, the cremation site of Mahatma Gandhi. It is a black marble platform that marks the spot of Gandhi's cremation, *Antyeshti* (Antim Sanskar) on 30 January 1948, a day after his assassination. It is left open to the sky while an eternal flame burns at one end. Located on Delhi's Ring Road, officially known as Mahatma Gandhi Road, a stone footpath flanked by lawns leads to the walled enclosure that houses the memorial. Later, we will tour New Delhi and drive past *Rashtrapati Bhawan* (President's House), *Parliament House*, and *India Gate* – a war memorial constructed in memory of 70,000 Indian soldiers who fought in World War I. Afternoon visit New Delhi which include, Humayun's Tomb (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), an early example of fine Mughal architecture in India, built in 1565. Humayun's Tomb is often said to be the inspiration behind the Taj Mahal. Commissioned by Emperor Humayun's first wife, Empress Bega Begum, it was the first garden-styled tomb on the Indian subcontinent. The complex encompasses the main tomb of second Mughal Emperor Humayun, which houses the graves of Empress Bega Begum, Hamida Begum, and also Dara Shikoh- Shah Jahan's eldest son, as well as numerous other subsequent Mughal Emperors. Then, visit Qutub Minar (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), a soaring tower of victory. The marble and red sandstone-built structure is nearly 73 meters tall and tapers from a 15-meter-diameter base to just 2.5 meters at the top and contains a spiral staircase of 379 steps. Built in the 11<sup>th</sup> century, the design of the monument is inspired by the Minaret of Jam, in western Afghanistan. Overnight stay at hotel.





**DAY 09 – 08 JAN 20 – IN DELHI**

Breakfast at hotel. Full day free for leisure activities or do the shopping. Overnight stay at hotel.

**DAY 10 – 09 JAN 20 – DEPART DELHI**

**BY: INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT**

After breakfast check out from hotel and drop off at Delhi airport to board the flight for onward journey.....
