Day 2 - Tuesday, 24 Dec 19: Hanoi city highlights

HANOI CITY HIGHLIGHTS

Explore the charming city of Hanoi, often referred to as the 'Paris of the East', with its yellow ochre colonial buildings, tree-lined boulevards and scenic lakes. Visit the historic **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum**, an imposing monument of marble and granite built to house the preserved body of beloved revolutionary leader Ho Chi Minh, affectionately known to the Vietnamese as "Uncle Ho". Visit the **One Pillar Pagoda**, a Buddhist temple built in 1049 of wood in the shape of a lotus blossom and set on a single stone pillar. Continue to the **Temple of Literature**, Vietnam's first national university built in the late 11th century. The picturesque temple is an example of well-preserved traditional Vietnamese architecture and is featured on the back of the 100,000 Vietnamese dong banknote. In the afternoon, visit the fascinating **Museum of Ethnology** (closed on Mondays) which houses an extensive collection of traditional costumes and artefacts from Vietnam's 54 ethnic minority groups. Drive back to central Hanoi for a walking tour through the famed **Old Quarter** known for its '36 streets of 36 wares' named after the original 36 artisan guilds that date as far back as the 13th century. Conclude your day by watching an entertaining **water puppet performance**, a uniquely northern Vietnamese art form said to have originated in the flooded rice fields of the Red River Delta where villagers entertained themselves by manipulating puppets over the water. The show uses colourful wooden puppets to depict scenes of rural life and episodes of national history set to music.

Day 3 - Wednesday, 25 Dec 19: Hanoi – Hai Phong – Ylang Cruise on Lan Ha Bay

Transfer from Hanoi to Pha Got- 3D2N with guide (approx. 1.5 hours).

Your luxurious floating home sets sail around noontime. Day 7 - Sunday, 29 Dec 19: Half day Hoi An Walking Tour - Making Bamboo Craft With Mr. Tan Vo

HALF DAY HOI AN WALKING TOUR

Between the 15th and 19th centuries, Hoi An known then as 'Faifo', was a prosperous trading port, attracting Chinese, Japanese, Dutch, Portuguese and Spanish ships amongst others. Today, this World Heritage ancient town is recognised for its well-preserved architecture, pedestrian-only streets and distinctive local cuisine, allowing visitors a glimpse of its illustrious past. Hoi An's narrow lanes are ideal for a guided walking tour of its many atmospheric sights including: the **old merchant houses** with influences from Chinese, Japanese and Vietnamese architecture; the 400-year-old **Japanese Covered Bridge**, first built in the 1590s by the Japanese community to link them with the Chinese quarters across the stream; the **Assembly Hall of the Chaozhou Chinese Congregation** with its intricate woodcarvings; and **the colourful market** with stalls brimming with local specialties including silk, which can be turned into fashionable garments within a day or two.

MAKING BAMBOO CRAFT WITH MR. TAN VO

Bamboo tree is a significant symbol in both Vietnamese culture and daily life. The solid, straight and high bamboo trees represent the resilience, indomitability and bravery of the Vietnamese people. Today meet with Mr. Tan Vo, who represents the creative young generation and brings bamboo products up to another level. Having inherited valuable skills from his father, **Mr. Tan Vo has recently created a unique bicycle with the frame and handlebars made from bamboo.** The advantage of this type of special bamboo frame is its durability and flexibility. His family also hand-makes many other bamboo items which you can see and discover in the workshop. **Try your hands on making a pen holder or a décor item under his guidance** and take it home as a souvenir.

Day 8 - Monday, 30 Dec 19: Hoi An - Tra Que Village & Red Bridge Cooking Class

Early morning welcome drink and program overview at Hai Café. Drive to the nearby **Tra Que Vegetable Village** to observe local farmers working the organic fields using traditional methods that date back hundreds of years. The rich soil from this village produces some of the most flavoursome vegetables and herbs in all of Hoi An. Pick fresh sawtooth coriander and Vietnamese mint for your cooking lesson later today before visiting a local home and trying a special herbal drink. Transfer to the **Red Bridge Cooking School** and freshen up before beginning your private class. Follow the demonstrations of the chef who will teach you the traditional methods of preparing and cooking Vietnamese food from scratch. Use fresh

ingredients with traditional Vietnamese utensils to **prepare four popular dishes**, including Vietnam's national dish of 'pho' noodle soup. After class, enjoy and **savour the dishes** you have prepared. Board a local boat for a short cruise along the Thu Bon River back to central Hoi An.

Day 11 - Thursday, 02 Jan 20: Visit Cu Chi Tunnels by private speedboat – City highlights

VISIT CU CHI TUNNELS (BY BOAT - PRV)

Morning transfer to the Jetty and depart for the Cu Chi Tunnels. Begin your **private speedboat** excursion and witness glittering skyscrapers and busy commercial centres giving way to green fields and stilt houses along the Saigon River. Arrive at the famous **Cu Chi Tunnels**, an immense network of connecting underground tunnels started in 1948 to protect the Viet Cong guerrillas from the French air and ground sweeps. The tunnels also served as living quarters, communication and supply routes, and housed hospitals, food and weapons caches. Touring **the underground compounds** will provide a better understanding of the history of the tunnels, the hardship of life in the tunnels and the Vietnamese resilience during combat. Return by private speedboat to Saigon with a stop en route for lunch at a local restaurant.

- The speedboat journey takes approximately 1.5hrs each way, and slightly longer between March and May due to the water hyacinth season

CITY HIGHLIGHTS TOUR

With over eight million inhabitants and four million motorbikes, Saigon is truly a city that never sleeps. Despite its modernity, Saigon maintains a strong link to the past and our city tour takes in some of Saigon's most historic landmarks including the **Notre Dame Cathedral**, a red brick edifice with twin spires

constructed from materials imported from France (entrance is only permitted when no services are being performed). Then head across the square to the **Central Post Office**, completed in 1891. A short drive away is the former **Presidential Palace**, the headquarters of the Saigon Government during the American War. Continue to the **War Remnants Museum** for a vivid perspective of the American War through the eyes of the Vietnamese. (Please note that some of the displays are very graphic.) Experience Saigon's famed street coffee culture while your guide provides a brief language lesson as well as insights into daily life of a Saigonease before returning to your hotel.
