Included: - Breakfast - Guided tour of Split (2 h) - Private transfer to Trogir - Local guide in Trogir	Visit the Diocletian Palace in the heart of Split, built as a residential palace seventeen hundred years ago by the Roman Emperor Diocletian and also a priceless monument included in the UNESCO list of World Heritage. After the city tour you will have the time to spend at leisure. Enjoy the heart of Split – the famous Split waterfront or Riva where you will feel the friendly and cozy atmosphere of this vibrant city. Or check tip of the day and see what you can do in Split area. Private transfer to Trogir. Guided Tour of Trogir: Sightseeing in Trogir is a pure joy. It's a small town and Trogir's sights are conveniently clustered together, making it an easy walk and easy to understand why it is a UNESCO	

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Start your walking tour from the Renaissance city, above the gate is a statue of the town's protector, the Blessed Ivan Orsini. Nearby is the town museum which gives a good overview of Trogir's history. Continue to the town center with



magnificent cathedral of St. Lovro, built from the 13th to the 15th centuries and considered one of the Adriatic's most architecturally and artistically important monuments. Continue sightseeing to numerous other monuments, like The elegant bell tower, Chapel of Blessed John Orsini, a Renaissance masterpiece, numerous churches and Kamerlengo fortress. Plenty to explore and enjoy this historical Dalmatian town.

Return to Split and at leisure.

Tip of the day - OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES IN SPLIT AREA:

- WINE TASTING AT BIBICH WINERY: in the cellars of the Bibic Winery, a signature event for lovers of fine wine and food in Croatia. The vineyards are located in the rolling hills above historic Skradin and Krka National Park in the bucolic village of Plastovo. Among the most celebrated in the country, most of Bibic's limited production is sold only in very select shops and served in the finest restaurants- the rest is exported to US and Europe.
- ATV QUAD TOUR & DALMATIAN VILLAGES: Our bike adventure is adapted to all age groups, no previous knowledge necessary. Short training to prepare for departure. Your ATV Quad adventure begins as you pass through a lot of villages of Dalmatian hinterland, ride continues on wild roads that are perfect for ATV Quad bikes and offer maximum enjoyment. Continue to ride along the river Cetina to the place where our ATV safari began. After this amazing tour, you will be served with a homemade meal prepared with local groceries.
- NP KRKA WATERFALLS (HALF-DAY TRIP): Drive towards National Park Krka, where the river Krka formed cascades and waterfalls of majestic forms. The waterfalls are a karstic phenomenon: over millennia river water has created a canyon up to 200m deep through limestone hills, bringing calcium carbonate with it. Mosses and algae retain the calcium carbonate and encrust it in their roots. The material is called tufa and is formed by billions of plants growing on top of one another. These growths create barriers in the river that produce spectacular waterfalls.

DAY 4: Tuesday, September 10 Split - Hvar

In the morning catamaran to Hvar island. Check in at the hotel.

Self guided tour of old town of Hvar: Hvar is best known for its medieval buildings which are the legacy of four centuries of Venetian rule. The town is the site of the oldest municipal theatre in Europe which opened in 1612. Perched high on a hill overlooking the town, the gleaming white limestone walls of the medieval Spanjol Fortress afford breath-taking views for those that climb to their summit. (optional) You will also visit the Cathedral and the Arsenal followed by time to lunch and enjoy Hvar Town's stone-paved harbour front, the Venetian piazza and yacht harbour with views across the sparkling Adriatic Sea.

- HIKING HVAR: Pathways lead you through the olive trees and lavender fields, through vineyards, forests and inlets. A visit to the old island villages, of which some are abandoned (Humac, Malo Grablje...), will give you an insight into the past and the old way of life on the island. Hiking to the highest peak called St. Nicholas (628m), from where you can see all islands of central Adriatic and the mountains of hinterland.
- CYCLING ON HVAR ISLAND: Hvar is a natural paradise. What is better way than to experience its magic close up through a challenging bike ride through its fields and picturesque inland villages, where time has stood still, and whose secrets are there to be discovered. Cycle through the inland villages of Dol, Svirce and Vrisnik, before hitting the coast through Jelsa and Vrboska, much of it the route of the 500 year-old UNESCO Easter Procession.
- WINE TASTING OF FUTURE MILLENNIUM: Take wine tasting by Andro Tomic wine maker – try his Mali Plavac wine, as "La Revue du vin de France", the respected wine magazine, distinguished his wine as being a benchmark for
