### Uros + Taquile + Amantani 2D/1N

FIRST DAY (Uros and Amantani):

On this tour we will visit first the Uros floating islands taking a comfortable boat from the port of Puno (30 minutes) after visiting 2 floating islands will continue with the journey to Amantani island (2 ½ hours) and arrive at the average noon where we will be warmly welcomed by local families.

Accompanied by the families we will hike (30 min uphill) to local houses, where we have lunch typical Andean food on the island. After settling and rest we will hike to the top of the island to meet the Pachamama and Pachatata Inca ceremonial temples .

After enjoying the beautiful views of the lake and its splendor, we wait until sunset to enjoy one of the most beautiful sunsets in the world. Finally we return to dine at local houses, overnight families organized a welcome party (optional) where we can dance and wear the local dress all accompanied by local musicians.

SECOND DAY (Amantani and Taquile):

We started the day with a typical breakfast and then descend to the port (8 am), we will take our boat to Taquile Island, walk uphill to the main square, where we can see the island and learn more about the customs and textiles of the island, after lunch we descend to the port of Taquile (1:00 pm.) to return to Puno where we arrive at 4:00 pm averaging.

#### Cusco City Tour - 4 Ruins

Welcome to the city of Cusco, the spiritual center and ancient capital of the Incas. Cusco was called “the navel of the world” as it was the center of the four corners of the Tawantinsuyo Empire.

We will start with our tour visiting the Qorikancha or Golden Temple considered by the Incas’ most important religious center. Next we will visit the impressive city of Cusco, built on top of the foundations of Inca palaces. We will visit the Plaza de Armas and the Cusco Cathedral and enjoy its beautiful architecture and colonial paintings.

Later on we will board a bus to visit the archaeological centers near the city. We will stop at the San Cristobal lookout where we will enjoy a panoramic sight of Cusco. Next we will visit Sacsayhuaman. We will see its impressive stone buildings and hear about the construction techniques used by the Incas. We will continue our journey through the ceremonial centers of Quenqo, Puka Pukara and Tambomachay.

Once you arrive in Aguas Calientes, you will be greeted by our staff. After a briefing you will be taken to the bus stop to board the bus that will take you to the Historical Sanctuary of Machu Picchu in approximately 25 minutes. Once you arrive to Machu Picchu the guide will start your tour. Machu Picchu is surrounded by dramatic landscape between the Peruvian Andes and the Amazon Basil, Machu Picchu is maybe the greatest wonder of ancient architecture in the world. It symbolizes the Inca culture with all its historical, cultural and natural values. Machu Picchu is divided into a lower and upper part to separate farming from residential areas. It consists of subsidiary centers, an extensive road and trail system, irrigation canals and agricultural terraces. At the end of the tour, you will have the option to remain in Machu Picchu for a while or board the return bus that will take you back to Machu Picchu Pueblo. You will board the return train to the city of Ollantaytambo at the scheduled time. Pick-up at the train station and transfer to your hotel Cusco.
