The Crown Treasure and Silver Vault are a special highlight at Charlottenburg Palace. Ticket of Charlottenburg Palace is valid for all the SPSP museum institutions in the Charlottenburg Palace Gardens (except for special exhibitions).

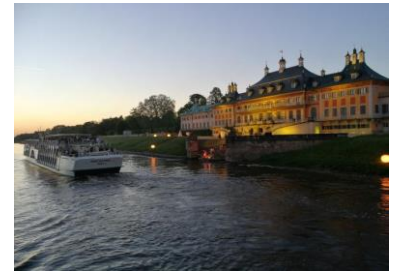

A selection of over 100 exhibits comprising paintings, photographs, charcoal drawings, pastels, lithographs and personal memorabilia provides a privileged view into the universe of the artist who is most widely known for the posters he executed for Sarah Bernhardt in the fashionable world of fin-de-siècle Paris. - SELECTION OF BEST MUSEUMS & GALLERIES IN PRAGUE: Prague National Gallery and National Museum, Prague City Gallery (the second most significant art institution in the Czech Republic after the National Gallery with large collection of Czech art of the 19th, 20th and 21st centuries), Czech Museum of Fine Arts, National Technical Museum, Magical Cavern Museum, Prague Jewish Museum and many others. - ČEŠKE BUDEJOVICE & KRUMLOV: Tour to Češke Budejovice where famous Budweiser beer is being brewed. Visit to the factory. Continue to picturesque, historical UNESCO Cešky Krumlov, guided tour (2hrs), back to Prague - HALF-DAY TOUR TO KUTNA HORA: Kutna Hora is one of the 12 places in the Czech Republic on UNESCO’s world heritage list, but is most 	
		
		

on UNESCO's world heritage list, but is most famous for its bone church; a cemetery chapel decorated with the bones of up to 40,000 people. There are at least three of these 'bone chapels' (or 'ossuaries') in the Czech Republic and many more scattered across Europe, but the creative arrangements of the bones in Kutná Hora make it more memorable than most.

All rooms at the H+ Hotel Berlin Mitte feature satellite TV and a modern bathroom with shower. Free WiFi is available in all rooms.

A range of breakfast options and international dishes are served in the H+ Hotel's bright restaurant. Snacks and drinks can be enjoyed at the stylish bistro bar.

Just a 5-minute walk from the Natural History Museum and a 20-minute walk from the Brandenburg Gate and the Unter den Linden Boulevard, the H+ Hotel Berlin Mitte is an ideal base for exploring Germany's capital.

The hotel offers great transport links, with Naturkundemuseum Underground Station just 100 m away and Berlin Central Station a 15-minute walk away.

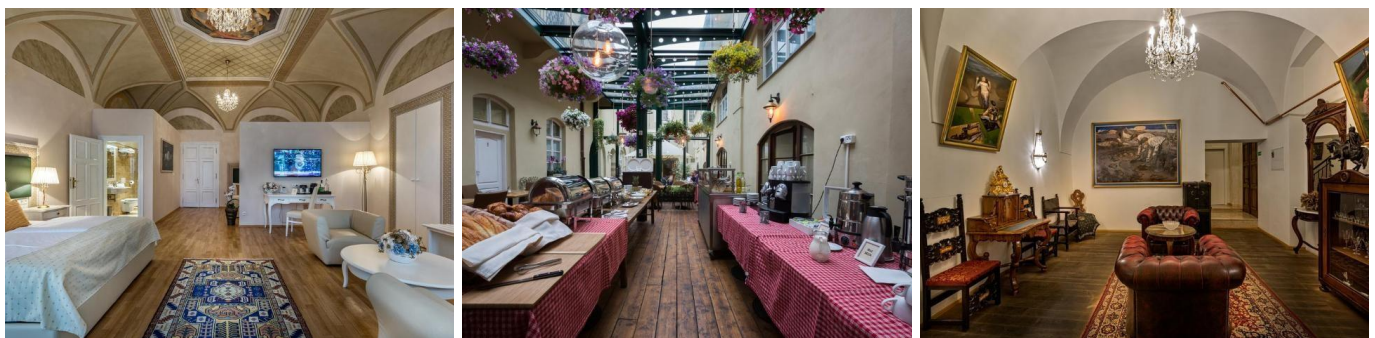
Rooms at the Leonardo Hotel Dresden Altstadt are air-conditioned and soundproofed. The rooms are equipped with a desk, safe, telephone, TV and tea/coffee facilities. The bathrooms come with a shower, cosmetic mirror, hairdryer and a WC.

Set in a historic building from the 15th century right next to the Charles Bridge in the centre of Prague, Residence U Malvaze offers accommodation with free WiFi access, a garden and onsite restaurant.

The rooms are all fitted with a TV and private bathroom with shower. Other amenities include a minibar with Espresso coffee machine, L'Occitane cosmetics, bathrobes, slippers, as well as a safety deposit box. The rooms are accessible via stairs.

The U Malvaze restaurant carries on the tradition of an old brasserie in the city, offering Czech and international cuisine and selection of beer. Breakfast is also served at the restaurant and in the winter garden. An airport shuttle can be arranged for a surcharge.

Many shops, restaurants, cafés and bars are in the immediate vicinity of Residence U Malvaze. Old Town Square
