Day 1, Arrival Amman (35 Km)

Upon arrival, a member of our staff will meet you at Queen Alia International Airport. Transfer to hotel in Amman.

Overnight at hotel

Day 2, Amman/ Ajlun/ Jerash/ Dead Sea (205 Km) 22nd April

Breakfast. Morning transfer north to visit the town of Ajlun with its fortress; one of the best preserved examples of medieval Arab military architecture in the entire Middle East, which was once governed by Saladin. Enjoy the magnificent view into the Jordan Valley. Proceed to visit the Greco-Roman City of Jerash, also known as the City of the thousand columns. Jerash showcases the grandeur of Imperial Rome (and is sometimes referred to as the Pompeii of the East). It is considered one of the largest, and most well preserved sites of Roman architecture in the World outside Italy. As the most pristine Decapolis City (meaning ten cities in Greek) in the modern world, Jerash's prosperity can be admired in the colonnaded main street and lovely Oval Piazza. Transfer to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on Earth located 395 meters below sea level. Float in its unique salt rich waters which make it nature's natural spa. Free time at leisure.

Day 3, Dead Sea/ Madaba/ Mt.Nebo/ Wadi Mujib/ Kerak/ Petra (405 Km) 23rd April Breakfast. Departure through the King's Highway, an ancient route that still has marks left from traders, armies and pilgrims who crossed it centuries ago, which was once part of the ancient Silk Road. Visit the Christian Town of Madaba, which is known as 'The City of Mosaics'. You will be visiting the St. George Greek Orthodox Church, where you will see the masterpiece of Madaba (a Byzantine mosaic map of the Holy Land that goes back to the 6th century, showing Jerusalem and other cities), you will also visit the Archaeological Park, which houses the remains of several Byzantine churches, including the amazing mosaics of the Church of the Virgin. The park complex includes a school for the restoration and conservation of ancient mosaics. We will then go to Mt. Nebo, which is considered to be one of the most important holy sites in Jordan, as it is believed to be the place where Moses climbed from the Valley of Moab, and from where God showed him the Promised Land, as well as Moses' last resting place. It features ruins from the 4th to the 6th century with marvelous mosaics adorning the grounds of the church still visible. Proceed through Wadi Mujib, a deep valley holding one of Jordan's most breathtaking views. We will continue our journey to the city of Kerak, where we will visit the Crusader's Castle, with its diverse history dated from the Byzantine to the Mamluk period, and get to know the architectural military brilliance of the Crusaders. Continue to Petra. In the evening, enjoy the magic of Petra by night. You can do candle light walk.

Overnight at hotel.

#### Day 4, Petra 24th April

Sunrise tour (opens at 6am) about 45 minutes to reach treasure and enjoy the scene when the sun light shines at it. Guide for 2 hours and stay in attraction.

If you come back to hotel for breakfast and re-enter it is an extra fee.

We will start our journey to explore Petra, aptly described as the "rose-red city, half as old as time". The ancient city was founded by the Nabateans 2000 years ago. Its massive architectural structure and its

multicolored stones are an incredible attraction. The visit of the ancient Nabatean capital starts on horseback, followed by a walk through the Siq, a long narrow fissure between two overhanging cliffs. Towards the end of the Siq, you will be spellbound by Petra's most famous monument; the Treasury. The tour then proceeds to gradually unfold the mysteries of the city.

Continue south to the enchanting desert of Wadi Rum, Jordan's largest desert and one of the most spectacular desert landscapes in the world. Jeep Tour inside the Wadi. Watch the most beautiful view while drinking a cup of traditional Bedouin tea. Transfer to the campsite inside the desert. Dinner , after dinner transfer to enjoy the Star Gazing experience inside the desert, overnight at camp.

SunCity Camp (1 night, Martian Tent) on Half Board basis Meals Breakfast

Day 6, Wadi Rum/ Amman (300 Km) 26th April Breakfast. .Transfer back to Amman via desert highway. Overnight at hotel W Amman Hotel, 5\* (3 nights, Wonderful Room) on Bed & Breakfast Meals Breakfast

Day 7, Amman Special City Tour (24 Km) 27th April

After breakfast, Drive to the down town area to visit the ruins of the Amman Roman theatre, the Citadel and the Umayyad Palace. The tour includes visits to the Archaeological and Folklore Museums and a short walk through the souks and markets culminating in a visit to the Jordan Museum. Explore the city further and proceed to the Rainbow Street, one of Amman's oldest suburbs with very interesting architecture from the 20th century. Proceed to enjoy the Wine tasting experience at JR wines, Jordan's award winning wine producers, where you will be able to sample 3 different local wine varieties. Transfer back to the hotel .
