Day 1 - 6 (Victoria Falls)

Day 6: Vic Falls to Thebe River Lodge (B, D) (80km)

Morning transfer from Vic Falls to Kasane (Check Visa Requirements) arriving at Thebe River Lodge on the Okavango River. Relax at the lodge pool before an enjoyable dinner at the lodge restaurant.

Day 7: Thebe River Lodge (B, L, D)

A full day of activities are included from our lodge on the Chobe river. This includes a Boat Cruise on the Chobe River and an open vehicle Game Drive in the Chobe National Park.

Day 8: Thebe River Lodge to Namushasha Lodge (B, L, D) (240km)

Departing Kasane, we continue through the Chobe and the nGoma Border Post (Check Visa Requirement) into the Caprivi Strip of Namibia. Passing through Katima Mulilo, we continue through the Caprivi with possible Elephant sightings. Turning off at Kongola, we continue down the Kwando to our lodge on the Kwando River.

Day 9: Namushasha (FB)

Enjoy the day at Namushasha Lodge with 2 activities during the day including a boat cruise (dependant on water level) and a visit to the local village where we will learn of their customs, traditions and way of life in the Caprivi.

Day 10: Namushasha Lodge to Kasane (B) (240km)

Departing Namushasha Lodge, we continue through the small village of Shangwali, back to Katima and the border of nGoma to Kasane for your departure flight.

Your Luggage should consist of

- One large kit bag
- One item of hand luggage (e.g. a small backpack)

Personal Equipment for Luxury Safaris to Southern Africa

- Passport (must be valid at least another 6 months from date of entry)
- Hat/Cap
- Warm Jacket

- Swimming Costume
- Natural Clothing (i.e. No bright colours)
- A pair of light weight long pants and a lightweight long sleeve shirt (to use against the sun)
- Comfortable walking shoes and strops/sandals
- Camera Equipment, Binoculars, and lots of spare memory cards & batteries
- Water bottle

Toiletries for Luxury Safaris to Southern Africa

- Personal Toiletries in small bag, not a vanity case
- Suntan Lotion and block out for the face
- Mosquito repellent lotion/spray

Visas
