Detailed Program

Day 1- (29 Nov 19) Yangon Arrival and transfer to hotel

Upon arrival at Yangon International Airport, you will be welcomed by our driver and transferred to hotel for leisure.

Day 2- (30 Nov 19)

Yangon Full Day Sightseeing



After having breakfast at the hotel, we will pick you up at the hotel at 08:30 AM. Then we will visit to downtown Yangon's bustling streets, visiting some of the British colonial-era architectural gems that remain and the boulevard-like Pansodan Street, which is famous for its architecture and its street-side bookstalls.

After that continue we will walk to Secretarial Office by passing through Bogalayzay Road, which was the home and administrative seat of British Burma. Then you have the chance to browse for Myanmar crafts at the Bogyoke Aung San Market.

In the afternoon we will visit to the picturesque Kandawgyi Lake (former Royal Lake) and the Reclining Buddha at Chauk Htet Gyi, still a popular place for Buddhist worshippers.

Our day ends with a visit to the Shwedagon Pagoda, the most important religious structure in Myanmar and a point of pilgrimage for Buddhists across the globe.

Day 3- (01 Dec 19) Fly to Nyaung U and visit around Bagan archeological sites



After having breakfast at the hotel we will transfer to Yangon domestic airport and fly to Nyaung U.

Upon arrival at Bagan, we will visit to Shwezigone Pagoda, a prototype for many Myanmar stupas built later. Then continue visit to Htilominlo Temple which is known to be the last Myanmar Style temple built in Bagan and visit the 13th century cave temples at Wetkyi-in-Gubyaukgyi, one of Bagan's most famous sites the Ananda Pagoda and many other temples dotted around this vast, beautiful

complex.

Afternoon sightseeing highlights include more of Bagan's impressive pagodas such as Sulamani Temple built in by King Narapatisithu, Dhammayangyi Temple, and a massive later period temple with the finest brickwork in Bagan. Later we will enjoy Bagan famous sunset at the best place.

Day 4- (02 Dec 19) Morning Hot Air Balloon ride in Bagan and visit to Nyaung U Market, Minnanthu and Phwar Saw villages



Early morning, before sunrise, you will be picked up and treated with a light pre-flight breakfast while the balloons fill up. During the flight, you will have a 360 degree panoramic view of the entire region giving you a memorable experience that no other form of transportation can offer.

Complimentary refreshments paired with a glass of chilled sparkling wine come after floating over Bagan's stunning immensity. After this memorable experience return to your hotel and enjoy the breakfast.

After having breakfast at the hotel, we will first visit to Nyaung U Market to taste the local life before visit to a local monastery (Lawkanandar Monastery) at 10:30 AM, little crowded, where about 130 monks line up daily and pray before taking their lunch. The monks amass fascinating tree fossils thousands of year's old and great value.

In the afternoon, we will visit to Minnanthu Village, an agricultural village which specializes in the production of sesame and peanut oil. The village is well worth to look around. This is followed by visits at Tayokepyay Lacquer-ware making. Then we will continue visit to Phwar Saw Village near Minnanthu Village.

Day 5- (03 Dec 19) Bagan to Mandalay by car/ Mandalay – Amarapura sightseeing



After having breakfast at the hotel, we will drive to Mandalay and visit Mandalay's sights and explore the incredible choice of pagodas and monasteries in Myanmar's cultural capital.

Highlights in the town include the highly-revered Mahamuni Pagoda, the wood-carved Shwenandaw Monastery and the world's largest book at Kuthodaw Pagoda.

In the evening we will transfer to another former capital, Amarapura is just outside the town's limits, and we will travel here to enjoy the beautiful sunset from the world-famous U Bein Bridge, which is thought to be the longest teak bridge in the world.

Day 6- (04 Dec 19) Inwa and Sagaing sightseeing



After having breakfast at the hotel we will explore to the ancient capitals close to Mandalay, our first will be to another former royal capital, Inwa, which was founded in 1364 and was the royal capital for nearly 400 years. Highlights here include the 'leaning tower of Ava', Maha Aungmye Bonzan Monastery, which was built by masonry as opposed to most other monasteries which are built with wood, and the elegant teakwood Bagaya Monastery.

Later visit to Sagaing, which was the capital of the Shan Kingdom in the 14th Century and briefly the capital in the 18th Century, as part of the Konbaung Dynasty. The town is located slightly downriver from Mandalay and has many interesting stupas scattered over Sagaing Hill.

Day 7- (05 Dec 19) Fly to Heho/ Inle Lake and Thaleoo sightseeing



In the morning, we will transfer to Mandalay Domestic airport and fly to Heho.

Upon arrival, we will start our sightseeing by long tailed boat to the Phaung Daw Oo pagoda, which is the most highly revered monastery in the Inle Lake area. It houses five ancient images of the Buddha that are completely covered in gold leaf. And then visit to Nge Phe Chaung monastery and floating gardens.

Then continue visit to Thale Oo village, which is nothing more than an authentic agricultural village on the shore of the lake. Abundant rice fields and you can observe the difference in the vegetation.

After sightseeing, we will drive to Heho airport and fly to Yangon. Upon arrival at Yangon, we will transfer to hotel for leisure.
