Independent Oslo Sightseeing

Start your way by having a promenade across Karl Johans gate, the central street that consists of two twin arteries. The central street is also a place where you can see many of Oslo's important (and historical) edifices, including the Royal Palace of Oslo, Oslo University, Storting (the Parliament), National Theater, and the Cathedral of Oslo.

The Oslo City Hall, a monumental red-brick building, is located just 5 minutes of walking away from the central street. It took more than 3 decades to erect this building, which depicts the entire history of the Norwegian nation. Around that area, you can also explore Aker Brygge, a popular venue among locals and foreigners alike, Akershus Fortress, and Nobel Peace Center.

Oslo is also well known for its sculptural parks, and visiting Gustav Vigeland Park, Tjuvholmen Sculpture Park, and Ekeberg Park is a must. The modern area of Tjuvholmen is particularly appealing to those who are interested in contemporary art, with the Astrup Fearnley Museum being the key magnet for such curious minds.

Viking Guided Tour Vesfold

One-of-a-kind tour tells you about the history of the Vikings. We take you to iconic places located along Oslo fjord to show one of the oldest visible traces of the Viking Age dating back to 400-600AD. The tour continues to Oseberghaugen where one of true Viking ships was dug out in 1904. You will visit Norway's oldest city Tønsberg, or Tunsberg as it used to be called, founded in 9th century by Konung Harald Fairhair.

Next stop at Borrehaugen (Borre). It is the largest burial mound site in Northern Europe and now belongs to Borre National Park.

After we return to Oslo you will see the Oseberg and other ships in the Viking museum at Bygdøy.

Norway in a Nutshell: Oslo - Myrdal - Flåm

Depart from Oslo by train early in the moming. This unique and popular day-excursion takes you through some of the most magnificent scenery to be found on the west coast of Norway. Today skilled workers, effective equipment, tunnels and snowtunnels make the railway one of the safest and most comfortable ways of travelling between Oslo and Bergen. The journey on the Flåm Railway is regarded as one of the high points on the Norway in a Nutshell tour. The 20 km-long train journey from the mountain station of Myrdal and down to Flåm deep in the fjord takes around 55 minutes. On the journey you have views of some of the most magnificent mountain scenery in Norway with an ever-changing panorama of tall mountains and thundering waterfalls. Along the Flåm Railway the train moves slowly or stops at the best views.

Visit Viking Farm

The Viking Farm is situated a ten minutes walk from the Middle Age church at Avaldsnes. You will find it on a small, forested island, just inside the rocks where king Olav Tryggvason drowned a group of wizards one thousand years ago.

In the farmyard you will find a longhouse, a boat house for a Viking warship, a roundhouse and several smaller buildings. Outside the farmyard there are paths through the forest for those who will just seek some peace and tranquility.

Viking for a day

Old written sources tell that Harald Fairhair and other Viking kings had their seats here at Avaldnses.

In the activity program "Viking for a day" you can dress up as a Viking and experience what life was like the Viking age.

What did the Vikings eat and how did they live? How was it to be a child in the Viking Age; what did they play with, and how did they become strong enough to carry swords and heavy shields? And why did the Viking kings choose to live exactly here at Avaldsnes?
