Day 1: 16.06.2020

Arrival at Florence Airport and transfer to the reserved Hotel in Florence. Free dinner and Overnight stay.

Day 2: 17.06.2020

FLORENCE In the morning visit Basilica di San Lorenzo with its Medici Chapel. Afterwards visit of San Marco. The convent, which is now a museum, has three claims to fame. During the 15th century it was home to two famous Dominicans, the painter Fra Angelico and the preacher Girolamo Savonarola. Also housed at the convent is a famous collection of manuscripts in a library built by Michelozzo. Then on to the visit of the Galleria dell' Accademia, famous for the Michelangelo's Sculptures. A must is also the visit of the Duomo and the Baptistry! Walk to the Santa Maria Novella church. Free dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 3 18.06.2020

FLORENCE Walking tour in Florence. The Rucellai Palace Visit of the Bargello museum. The Bargello, also known as the Bargello Palace, Museo Nazionale del Bargello, or Palazzo del Popolo (Palace of the People) is a former barracks and prison, now an art museum. Visit also Palazzo Strozzi. Then walk to Santa Croce. This monument is truly unique, not only for the purity of the Gothic style, but also for the famous works of art it contains and its historical importance. The most famous funeral monuments: the tomb of Michelangelo, Galileo, Macchiavelli. In the afternoon visit of Palazzo Vecchio and guided tour of the Uffizi. Free Dinner. Overnight stay

Day 4 19.06.2020

FLORENCE and WINE & OLIVE OIL TASTING After Breakfast Free time to enjoy the wonderful city. After lunch, by private car you will reach a wine cellar for a tasting. Continuation to Lucca. Free dinner and Overnight stay in Lucca.

Day 5: 20.06.2020

Lucca: After breakfast walking tour of Lucca. Most of the attractions in Lucca today show its ancient history: from the trace of the Roman amphitheater that can be seen in the shape of the Piazza

dell'Anfiteatro to the archeological remains under the 12th century church of Saints Giovanni and Reparata, to the various towers and villas from the 12th to 16th centuries.

Day 6 21.06.2020

PISA After breakfast departure to Pisa with The Piazza dei Miracoli Square of Miracles, formally known as Piazza del Duomo, a wide walled area, recognized as an important center of European medieval art and one of the finest architectural complexes in the world. Back to the Hotel. Free dinner and overnight stay in Lucca

Day 7 22.06.2020

CERTALDO, SAN GIMINIANO & VOLTERRA Today you will discover the Tuscan hinterland, with its famous villages and history. Certaldo was the home of the family of Giovanni Boccaccio, poet of "Vita di Dante," who died here at his home and was buried here in 1375. San Gimignano, known as the Town of Fine Towers, is famous for its medieval architecture, unique in the preservation of about a dozen of its tower houses. Continuation to Volterra. Main attractions are the bronze statuette "Shadow of the Night" and the sculpted effigy of an Etruscan couple in terra cotta. Interesting are also the Etruscan walls, including the well-preserved Porta dell'Arco (3rd-2nd centuries BC) and Porta Diana gates. Overnight stay in Siena

Day 8: 23.06.2020

Siena: Visit of Classical Siena (Duomo Piazza del Campo) then one of the CONTRADA with its Museum. The most well-known contrade are probably the 17 contrade of Siena that race in the Palio di Siena. Each is named after an animal or symbol and each with its own long history and complicated set of heraldic and semi-mythological associations. Overnight in Siena.

Day 9: 24.06.2020 free time in Siena

Day 10: 25.06.2020

Arezzo: in the morning departure by private car to Arezzo _ overnight stay in Arezzo

Day 11: 26.06.2020

Visit arezzo: Arezzo is known today as the Gold Town due to the traditional production of gold jeweler since the VI century b.C. Infact Arezzo is an Etruscan town and Etruscans, very civilized and wealthy people, were famous for the production of gold jeweler and potteries. Arezzo is an extraordinary city of art renowned for its goldsmiths and antiques traders. The old town is home to valuable monuments including the imposing Medici Fortress, the Cathedral, the Diocesan Museum and the Basilica of San Domenico. The heart of the city is Piazza Grande, surrounded by buildings of various periods and styles - among them the Medieval towers and the Renaissance style Loggiato Vasariano. Overnight stay in Arezzo

Day 12: 27.06.2020

Cortona: after breakfast departure to Cortona by private car. Cortona, first discovering Etruscans, is one of the oldest and most civilized people in ancient history. You will have free time for walking around town to appreciate its "out of time" atmosphere with its tiny shops and art galleries. Back to the hotel and overnight stay in Arezzo

Day 13 28.06.2020

Montepulciano & Pienza: After breakfast departure by private car to Montepulciano. The many sumptuous residences and buildings you can admire while walking in the historical center still testify to the power and wealth of the noble families here during the 14th and 15th centuries. Confined within its ancient city walls and bastions, Montepulciano is crossed by a main long and wide street called the Corso from which a series of alleys and narrow streets. Afterwards continuation to Pienza In 1996, UNESCO decided to make the centre of Pienza into a World Heritage Site "*considering that the site is of outstanding universal value as it represents the first application of the Renaissance Humanist concept of urban design, and as such occupies a seminal position in the development of the concept of the*

planned "ideal town" which was to play a significant role in subsequent urban development in Italy and beyond. Back to the hotel and overnight stay.

Day 14: 29.06.2020

free time in the morning. After lunch departure to Saturnia. Free dinner and overnight stay.

Day 15 30.06.2020

UNDISCOVERED AREA = PITIGLIANO, MANCIANO, SATURNIA. To outsiders, Pitigliano looks like a fairytale village, jetting from striking, wild ridges and surrounded by lush valleys carved by the Lente and Meleta rivers. The soaring tuff walls, lined with **myriad** caves and tower houses, are nothing but the best of medieval architecture. The city's layout, **with houses** built vertically on the tuff overhanging, might not need city walls, but you'll be sure to find some spectacular military structures, such as the 12th-century Palazzo degli Orsini. During the day, wine tasting is foreseen. Back to the hotel, free dinner and overnight stay.

Day 16: 01.07.2020

SATURNIA & MULINO WATERFALLS (day at leisure): The Mulino Waterfalls are a magical and unique place that will certainly surprise you. Hot thermal waters gush from the top of a waterfall and fall into the limestone rocks below. Over the centuries the continuous flow of water has created many small natural pools in which to immerse yourself and be pampered by the warm waters so rich in beneficial and regenerating properties. Spending a few hours immersed in these warm natural pools will be a unique experience of its kind, both during the day, being able to admire the surrounding landscape made of countryside and small hills, both at night, illuminated only by the moon... The thermal waters of the Mill Falls have a constant temperature of 37°C all year round, so every season is perfect to visit them and be captivated by their beauty and the uniqueness of the water! Back to the hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 17: 02.07.2020

DEPARTURE BY PRIVATE CAR FROM SATURNIA TO THE AMALFI COAST.

In the morning, departure from Saturnia to Reach the Amalfi coast. On the way, We will stop at Caserta. Visit of the Royal Palace of Caserta, sumptuous residence of the Bourbon family, kings of the Reign of the Two Sicilies. Both, the Palace and the wonderful extensive gardens where designed by Luigi Vanvitelli, one of the major painters and architects of the Rococò. Continuation to Napoli. Check-in, Dinner in Hotel and overnight in Napoli.

Day 18: 03.07.2020

NAPLES

Breakfast in hotel and full day visit Naples. Day 19: 04.07.2020

PAESTUM, BUFFALO-FARM AND CHARTERHOUSE OF PADULA

Breakfast at the hotel and departure for Paestum, where we will visit the Archaeological Excavations, with impressive examples of temples built in full Doric style. The Greek temples of Paestum are some of the most stunning ancient monuments in Italy. An old tradition in the plain areas and former marshlands south of Salerno is the breeding of buffalos and the production of Mozzarella cheese. We visit a buffalo farm, get some interesting details about the production and naturally taste the typical buffalo products. **Mozzarella tasting**. Continuation to Padula and visit of the Charterhouse of Padula. The Charterhouse of San Lorenzo in Padula is a very large Carthusian monastery, actually the biggest in Italy and since 1998 UNESCO World Heritage site. Its building history covers 450 years, but the principal parts of the buildings are in Baroque style. Return to hotel overnight in Paestum area.

Day 20: 05.07.2020

AMALFI COAST / POSITANO

Religious and historical symbol of the city of Altamura is its Romanesque cathedral. Of the cathedral, what most draws the visitor's gaze is its portal, in Gothic style, rich in decorations and sculptures, and the arches on which 22 scenes depicting the life of Christ are carved. Free lunch.

After it, departure to Matera for the visit of the city famous for its Sassi (UNESCO World Heritage Site). With local guide visit the Cathedral of Matera, have a panoramic view (with explanation) on the Sassi Barisano and visit of the quartier Sassi Caveoso. Free time to spend all around enjoying the magical place. **Overnight stay HOTEL LOCANDA SAN MARTINO in Matera.**

Day 25- 10.07.2020 DEPARTURE FROM MATERA TO REACH SICILY / TAORMINA

Departure from Matera to reach the beautiful Island of Sicily. Arrival in the afternoon in the picturesque Taormina, spectacularly situated with narrow atmospheric streets. Check in in Hotel. Dinner and overnight stay. **Hotel Villa Diodoro in Taormina or similar.**

Day 26 – 11.07.2020

MOUNT ETNA / TAORMINA

After it, continuation to Siracusa, founded in 733 BC and once three times the size of Syracuse today, with a castle attributed to Archimedes and Greek and Roman theatres. **Lunch in the old market of Ortigia.**

Visit the historic centre on Ortigia peninsula and the fine Baroque cathedral. Check in in Hotel.

Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 28 - 13.07.2020**PIAZZA ARMERINA / AGRIGENTO**

Travel inland to Piazza Armerina to visit the Roman Villa del Casale. This morning we drive to Piazza Armerina where the Villa Romana del Casale, a UNESCO World Heritage Site is situated. The Villa was built during the end of the 3rd and beginning of the 4th century AD. Although the owner of the villa is not known for certain, he must have been someone of great wealth and importance. A leading theory is that this was the country retreat of Maximianus Herculeus, who was Emperor of the western part of the Roman Empire between 285 and 305 AD. It is especially noteworthy for the richness and quality of the mosaics which decorate almost every room; they are the finest mosaics in situ anywhere in the Roman world. **Lunch in Restaurant.** Continue to Agrigento to explore the 'Valley of the Temples', site of the ancient city. A guided visit will show you the "Valley of Temples" (UNESCO World Heritage), where among others you'll see the best conserved Doric temple of "Concordia". Check-in and Overnight.

Hotel Dioscuri bay Palace or similar.

Day 29 - 14.07.2020**SELINUNTE / MARSALA / PALERMO**

After Breakfast our trip continues along the south coast to Selinunte. This most western Greek colony was destroyed already by the Carthaginians and the archaeologists brought to light not only several temple ruins but also the remains of the acropolis, the fortified town centre with walls, roads and houses, all this located in a wonderful position directly on the Mediterranean Sea. The most well-known town of the region is certainly Marsala, and for a good reason: it's the center of the major wine production area and gives its name to the Marsala wine, a dessert wine similar to a Sherry or Port wine. The English played an important role either in the commerce of the Marsala wine as also in the archaeological excavations. **Her you will have a wine tasting.** Continuation to Palermo, to reach the Hotel. Check-in and overnight stay. Overnight and stay Hotel

Mercure Excelsior Palace or similar.

DAY 30 - 15.07.2020**PALERMO / MONREALE**

After Breakfast, full day visit of Palermo with the most important monuments of the Norman Byzantine period, built after the Christian victory over the Muslims, famous for their particular architectonic style and the marvelous golden mosaic illustrations of the Bible, as: Cathedral of Palermo, Palatine chapel inside the Norman Palace, La Martorana and San Cataldo. Interesting also the Cathedral of Monreale, famous for more than 6.000 sqm of Byzantine mosaics. **Street food lunch.** For lunch in Palermo we will try, a must!, the typical street food in a typical focacceria. Palermo, in fact, is famous for its street food such as panelle, arancini, bread and panelle, sfinciuni, muffuletta, etc. A veritable melting pot of ideas, recipes and dishes that have their roots in centuries of Sicilian, Greek, Arabic, Spanish and French culinary traditions. After it, continuation to Monreale for a walking tour. Return to hotel. Free evening and Overnight stay. Overnight and stay Hotel
