

## Shared City Tour + Anthropology Museum

Tue, 24 Dec

**Mexico City Tour:** City Tour visiting the historical center of Mexico City, one of the largest UNESCO World Heritage Cities. The tour includes major attractions such as: the Zocalo (main square), the National Palace (if available) with the murals of Diego Rivera, the Metropolitan Cathedral, as well as a panoramic view of the Templo Mayor, the City of the Azteca culture, with over 2000 years of history. Continue the tour to Chapultepec Park, driving along Paseo de la Reforma, and at the end visit the National Museum of Anthropology and History.

Also you visit the Palacio de Bellas Artes, is a cultural center located in the Historic Center of Mexico City. Considered as the maximum house of the expression of culture, it is the most important lyric theater and the most important center of the country dedicated to all manifestations of the fine arts. Unesco declared it an artistic monument in 1987.



The **Anthropology Museum** is an obligatory visit in the capital. The range of exhibits is exceptional and the architecture is simply superb, making this visit an unexpected pleasure. You will find impressive masterpieces such as the famous Sun Stone, or Aztec Calendar, segments of several pyramids, and many original masterpieces of the ancient Mesoamerica Cultures. This museum is one of the largest and most beautiful in the world; nevertheless it will be just a one hour visit.

## Shared excursion to Basilica of Guadalupe & Pyramids of Teotihuacan

Wed, 25 Dec

**Basilica de Guadalupe & Teotihuacan Pyramids:** Visit the “**Basilica de Guadalupe**”, the modern basilica was built in order to replace the Spanish construction of the 17th century. The old church still exists, but every day it sinks further into the swampy ground. The devotion to the “Dark Virgin of Guadalupe”, is so widespread that many Mexicans refer to themselves as “Guadalupanos”. This devotion is witnessed daily, with pilgrimages made on their knees to the basilica entrances; the atmosphere of the site is uniquely characterized by fervor and prayers.



**Teotihuacan:** This archaeological site was the most populated and dynamic city of the central valley in about 400 years AD. The Quetzalcoatl Temple, as well as the two impressive Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon, are immutable witnesses of Mexico’s glorious past. At the top of the pyramids you can get a superb view that spans all the plain

## Shared excursion to Xochimilco (Floating Gardens) + University City + Frida Kahlo Museum

Fri, 27 Dec

**Frida Kahlo Museum, Coyoacan, Xochimilco Floating Gardens:** Morning is dedicated to visiting one of the most popular museums in Mexico City, the **Frida Kahlo** or “Casa Azul” (Blue House) Museum in Coyoacan. Frida was an artist and renowned woman of the last century. She was wife of Diego Rivera, one of Mexico’s top muralists whose works of art are found around the world.



**Coyoacan** is one of the most well preserved colonial areas of Mexico City, where you will visit the market and main buildings around the “Plaza of the Coyotes”.

Continue on to **Xochimilco**, known as the “floating gardens” for its extended series of canals. This area, has kept its ancient traditions, despite being part of Mexico City. Enjoy the folklore of Xochimilco, on the colorful trajineras - Xochimilco launches-, between chinampas; small “floating” islands, covered with flowers and gardens.
