14 Sep / Day 1 – Portmeirion

Collect your car and drive along some of our favourite Welsh roads, taking in the Brecon Beacons and Cardigan Bay from the south, or the dramatic North Wales



towards Portmeirion. There is nowhere in the UK quite like the 'idea village' of Portmeirion, a slice of multi-coloured Italianate fantasy spread across the cliffs overlooking wide Afon Dwyryd estuary. Portmeirion Village is home to two hotels, a cluster of historic cottages, iconic architecture, a spa, stylish shops, award-winning restaurants, casual cafes, an Italian ice cream

parlour, exotic gardens and sandy beaches. Portmeirion is open to day visitors every day of the year except Christmas Day.

Overnight at Portmerion Village in Double room.

These rooms are situated in various locations around the village. All rooms have views of The Village or The Estuary. All rooms have en-suite bathrooms, televisions, Wi-Fi and tea or coffee making facilities. Guests enjoy free entry into Portmeirion Village and Gardens and use of the heated outdoor swimming pool (May - September).

Complimentary transport from the local train and bus stations is available on request. All residents are offered dedicated parking bays.

15 Sep / Day 2 – Portmairion – Blaenau Ffestiniog



After a fine Welsh breakfast catch the steam service to Blaenau Ffestiniog, the very epicentre of Welsh slate-mining. Travelling in classic Pullman first-class style or 3rd class carriage, the train chuffs its way through epic Snowdonia vistas, visiting atmospherically named stations such as Minffordd, Penrhyn and Tan y Bwlch along the way. At Blaenau Ffestiniog you may choose to stay on the train for the immediate return journey to Porthmadog, or the intrepid might like to take time to visit the

extraordinary nearby Slate Caverns.

Overnight at Portmerion Village in Double room

16 Sep / Day 3 Portmadog – Caernarfon

Steaming from Harbour station, the train meanders through more heroic Snowdonia landscape, visiting Pont Croesor, Beddgelert and Waunfawr stations amongst others on its way to Caernarfon. Here, you have time to explore Edward's intimidating fortress Caernarfon Castle, whose polygonal towers reinforced its intention as a seat of power. To this day it dominates the skyline of this evocative ancient market town.
