Its glorious walls, with their fortresses and bastions, offer a unique walk with view of the magical Elafiti islands. Guided walking tour through historical streets and sightseeing of city’s most renowned historic monuments.

Each part of Dubrovnik can surprise you with some overwhelming experience. From the Onofrio fountain to the City bell tower, along its main street, Stradun, Dubrovnik’s famous street of limestone, polished by years of footfall and in many other small and quiet cobblestone streets, every step in this town will be an experience par excellence.

Tip of the day

- **GAME OF THRONES:** We strongly recommend: Game of Thrones shooting sight (climb to the city wall and walk the full 1.24-mile (2-kilometer) circuit, offering breathtaking views across a sea and see where Game of thrones was shot).
- **CITY WALLS OF DUBROVNIK:** Dubrovnik is known for its distinctive Old Town, encircled with massive stone walls completed in the 16th century. A walk along Dubrovnik's famous city walls that surrounds the Old Town is a unique and wonderful experience and a must-do when visiting Dubrovnik. The walls are 1,940 meters long and you can walk all the way around them (it usually takes about 2 hours). However, you can get down half way.




If you do a private boat tour, price per person is from 250 EUR: Enjoy fantastic boat tour on Lake Como to cute town of Bellagio and further to Varenna. **Bellagio is an elegant and long-established tourist resort, which still retains considerable charm.** The historic village of Bellagio only has a population of around 200 and most locals live in other hamlets and villages on the headland. The tiny town is an excellent place for



wine lovers and the one who seek lovely views, classy boutiques, gardens, picturesque lanes, a choice of restaurants and bars.

Continue to Varenna, the attractive village on the eastern shore of Lake Como, looking over the central part of the lake towards Bellagio. Varenna's picturesque lanes and old fishermen's houses are unpretentiously appealing, and some visitors prefer as one of most remarkable resorts for retreat.

Tip of the day - optionally:

ENOTECA PRINCIPESSA: This winery is located in Bellagio, where the lake divides into its two branches. The proprietor is very knowledgeable and friendly and will guide guests through his wide selection of great local wines. It is also possible to purchase wines and have them shipped home, even if you live on another continent. Definitely worth a stop-off if you fancy sampling one of Lombardy's most famous exports.

- **CABLE CAR TO MATTERHORN GLACIER PARADISE:** Ascend by cable car to the famous top of Matterhorn glacier, set on a high plateau and surrounded by mountains 13,124 feet high. Fantastic highest viewing platform in Europe (3883m) – one of the best views I have ever seen in my life! During Summer you can hike or during Winter ski on the glacier.

- **GORNERGRAT VIEW POINT:** The Gornergrat railway is a mountain rack railway, it links the resort village of Zermatt, situated at 1,604 m above sea level, to the summit of the Gornergrat. Enjoy another fascinating viewpoint from Gornergrat (approx. 3 H without additional activities on the top, only view point). The Gornergrat (3,089 m) is one of those places that everyone should visit at least once in a lifetime. The mountain panorama and the glorious view of the Matterhorn is unforgettable.

- **ZERMATT HIKING DAY OF 5 LAKES:** The 5-Seenweg (Five Lakes Walk) is in a class of its own among hikes in the Zermatt mountains. The views of the mountain lakes are superb (with the Matterhorn reflected in three of them), and the trail is full of variety.

- **THE SUNTRAP of SUNNEGGA:** From Zermatt you can reach the Sunnegga family paradise by funicular in a few minutes. This suntrap at the heart of Matterhorn paradise is a magnet for explorers of all ages and an ideal starting point for the onward trip to Blauherd and Rothorn.

During the unhurried two-hour trip between Thun and Interlaken, you can indulge in fine cuisine while casting admiring gazes at the castles on the banks and the mountains beyond. - ROYAL RIDE TO THE PEAK OF MÄNNLICHEN: ride on a balcony on the roof of the aerial cableway, starting from railway station in Wengen heading up to the peak of Männlichen. The Royal Walk and especially the summit platform in crown form improve the magnificent view even more. If you feel more active you can hike part of the route up or down! - VISIT OF THE TRÜMMELBACH WATERFALLS: The Trümmelbach Falls are the world's only glacier waterfalls that are accessible underground by lift, galleries, tunnels, paths and platforms. They are part of the Lauterbrunnen Valley's 72 waterfalls, among them also the imposing Staubbach Fall. The hiking tour on mainly flat land leads from Lauterbrunnen to Stechelberg, past water gushing from vertical rock faces that are several hundred meters high. Ticket of 11 CHF/person payable on the spot! - 007 SCHILTHORN CABLE CAR: On the opposite side of the valley is the holiday resort of Mürren, accessible from Lauterbrunnen and Stechelberg. The cableway from Stechelberg continues to the peak of the Schilthorn at 2971 m, famous for being the setting where the 007 classic, 'On Her Majesty's Secret Service' was filmed. - SCHYHNIGE PLATTE: From Wilderswil, a five-minute walk from the Interlaken Ost railway station, you can take a rack-railroad that has been carrying sightseers up to the Schynige Platte since 	

it opened in 1893. Another advantage is a tranquility of the Alpine Gardens, with stunning views of not only the Alps but also of 650 vibrant plant species in their natural habitats. Gardens are open to the public from May to October. If you're lucky there may be locals playing traditional Swiss Alphorns at the Schynige Platte station.




