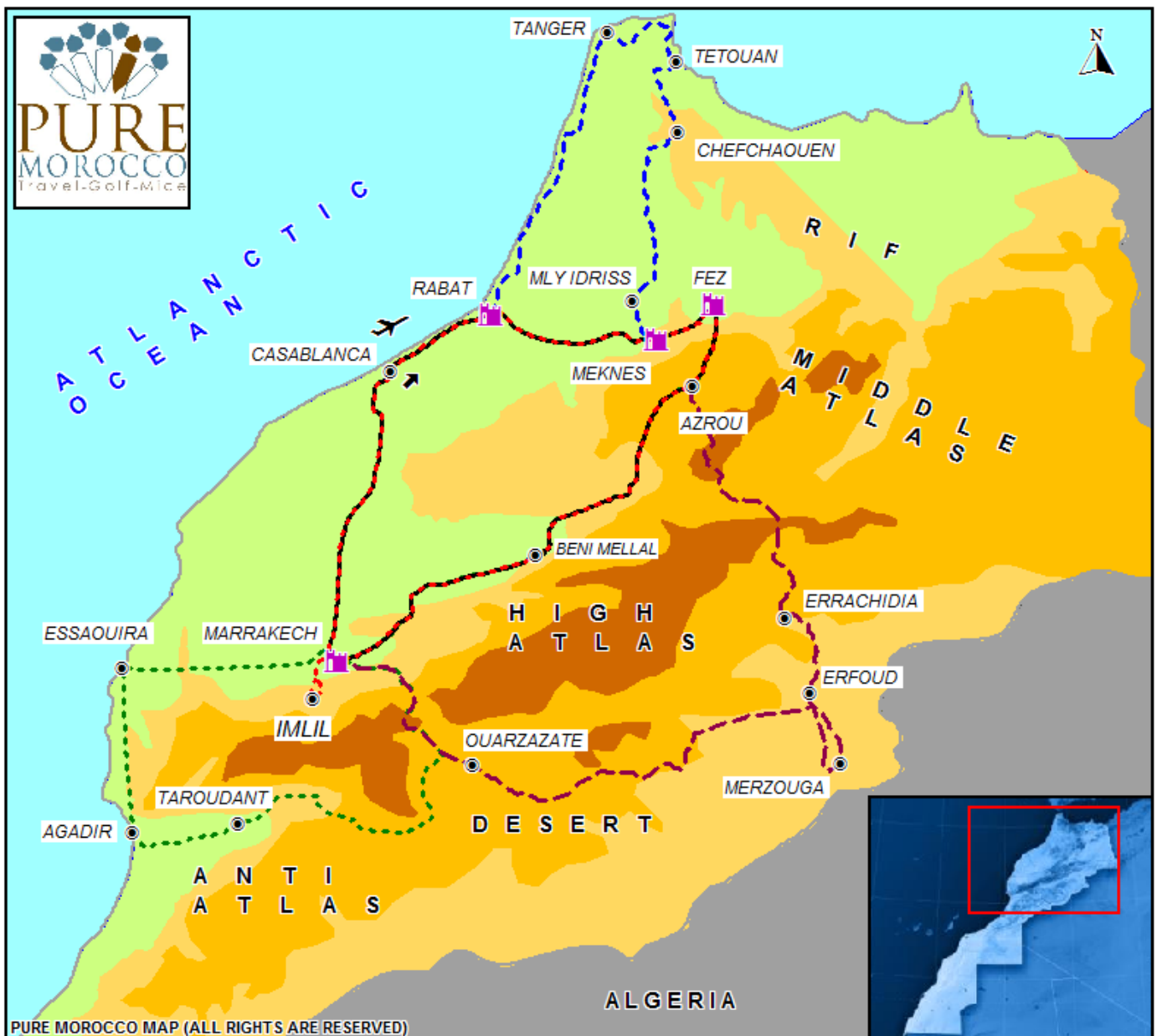

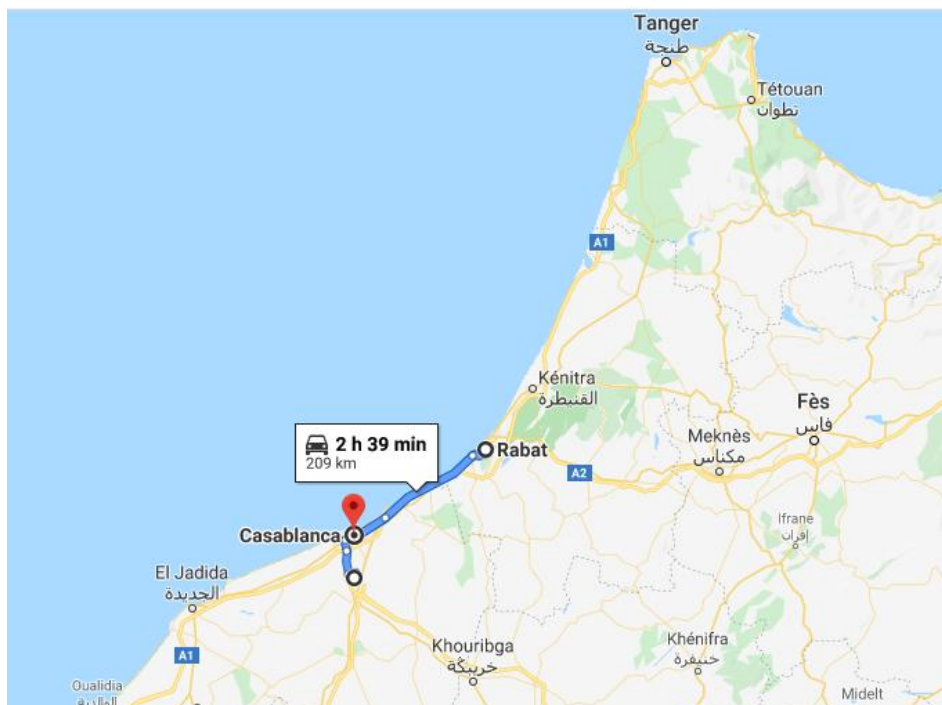

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY:

Feb 18: ARRIVAL TO CASABLANCA AIRPORT

MARHABA!!!

This is the traditional greeting used in Morocco, which conveys the meaning of a warm hello and welcome.

Today your flight arrives into Casablanca. After clearing customs and immigration procedures, you will be met by your driver, who will be waiting for you at the exit after the luggage check and inside the airport; he will be holding a sign with your name. Afterwards, you will be transferred to your hotel for check in and have an evening to rest.

The name Casablanca evokes thoughts of good living, romance and adventure in tropical setting, an image that the 1943 Humphrey Bogart film conveyed to cinema during World War II. Originally settled by Berbers in the 7th century, Casablanca's fairly recent growth has made it the bustling, French-influenced business centre of Morocco it is today.





Feb 19: FULL DAY EXCURSION TO RABAT

(87km/54mi- 1H10 min depending on the traffic via highway, without stops)

Today you will travel to Rabat, one of the country's four imperial cities, it is located on the Atlantic coast at the mouth of the Wadi BouRegreg, opposite the city of Salé. The history of Rabat is closely connected to that of Salé, the site of which was first occupied by the Roman settlement of Sala (Shella).

You will start by the visit of the magnificent **Tour Hassan mosque**, is the city's most famous sight. The massive minaret of Hassan dates back to 1195 and towers over Rabat. The huge mosque itself was never entirely completed and was largely destroyed in an earthquake in 1755. The Mohammed V Mausoleum is one of the greatest monuments of modern Morocco, which was inaugurated in 1967.

Then you will visit **Mohammed VI Museum**, Conceived and funded by the present king. This museum opened in 2014 as the country's first national museum of modern and contemporary art. Alongside a permanent display of Moroccan artists dating from the 1950s to the present day, it plays host to temporary exhibitions from big-name international artists.

Your city tour of Rabat will include a visit of **the Kasbah des Oudayas**, a picturesque place to take a stroll, see some sights and admire the interesting scenery.

The Kasbah was the Almohad citadel of medieval Rabat and is guarded by an impressive arched gate built around 1195. Inside the Kasbah is a palace and Andalusian gardens, as well as a broad terrace, where you can enjoy the beautiful views of the river and sea while sipping a mint tea.





Then you will visit **the famous Chellah**, where you will discover the ruins of a medieval Muslim necropolis and part of metropolitan Rabat's World Heritage Site. Fortifications surround much of the complex, built by the Marinids in the 13th century CE and including a mosque, royal tombs, and minaret. Ruins from previous constructions lie throughout the site, dating back as far as the Phoenicians.

Afterwards, you will return to your hotel in Casablanca.

FEB 20: CASABLANCA DEPARTURE

This morning, you will enjoy in the fascinating city of Casablanca, is the biggest city in Morocco located on the Atlantic Ocean and was modeled on the city of Marseilles by the French in 1920s.

In the morning, after your breakfast in the hotel, you will visit one of the few mosques that can be visited in Morocco **HASSAN II Grand Mosque**. Built on reclaimed land, almost half of the surface of the mosque lies over the waters of the Atlantic.

Then you will be transfer to the airport of Casablanca for a homebound flight.
