Day 1, April 16, 2020: Arusha town or Airport / Tarangire National Park

Following breakfast at your hotel or airport meet and have a short briefing with our licensed driver guide then depart to Tarangire national park where will be able to see a large number of elephants, wildebeest, zebras. Tarangire river is the source of water for wild animal during the dry season, many wild animals can be easily be spotted during the afternoon because they come to the riverbanks to drink water also there are many baobab trees in this Park. Enjoy a day game viewing of Tarangire River with picnic lunch. In the late afternoon your guide drives to Karatu town for dinner and overnight

Day 2 April 17, 2020: Marera Valley Lodge / Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, check-out from lodge at 08:00am ready for safari to Serengeti National Park

This park covers an area of 14,763 square kilometers and has a range of different habitats including open grasslands, marshes, forests and kopjes. There is so much to see and keep you occupied in Serengeti National Park. One of the best places to spot large predators like lions, leopards, cheetahs and hyenas is Seronera Valley. You can also see elephants, zebras, elephants, giraffes, wildebeest and many other species on any given day. Another highlight is the Moru Kopjes in central Serengeti, which is the best place to spot a black rhino. These rock formations (kopjes) dot the landscape and provide shade and great viewpoints for many animals, including lions, leopards and cheetahs. If you want to see about 200 splashing, playing hippos head to the Retina Hippo pool. This is one of the few places where you can get out of the car to take pictures

DAY 3 April 18, 2020: Full Day Serengeti National Park

Early in the morning before having your breakfast you will go for sun-rise game drives for about one hour, there after drive back to your Lodge for breakfast and pick up your lunch boxes then continue with game drive in the Serengeti National Park till evening.

You will spend the day moving around the different habitats looking for animals such as lions, leopards, cheetahs, hyenas, elephants, hippos, impala, zebras, wildebeest, Grant's gazelle, Thomson's gazelle and many others. There is a wide variety of bird life. The sheer size of this park and its amazing changing scenery makes this a day to remember.

DAY 4 April 19, 2020: Central Serengeti National Park / Descend Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast, check-out from lodge ready for en-route game drives to Arusha, on the way reach in Ngorongoro Conservation area. The crater is over 20 kilometers wide and approximately 600 meters deep. If you are lucky and have a clear day, from the bottom you will be able to see the whole way around the crater walls.

Ngorongoro Crater is one the largest intact caldera in the world and one of the most spectacular sights in the whole of Africa. All the BIG FIVE Rhino, Lion, Leopard, Buffalo and Elephant live in this wonderful caldera; others are Zebra, Hippo, Wildebeest, and Hyena. Birds include flamingos on the Soda Lake, Geese, Storks, Vultures and more other bird families are easily be

spotted. Enjoy a day game viewing OF Ngoitoktok springs picnic site in the late afternoon your guide drives to Karatu for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 April 20, 2020: Lake Manyara National Park / Back to Arusha

Following breakfast at the Lodge, depart to half day tour in Lake Manyara National Park

A soda lake covering almost two-third of the area, tree-climbing lions and the breathtaking scenery is what makes Lake Manyara National Park famous. Other wildlife you can spot includes hippos, bush babies, leopards, giraffes and over 400 bird species like flamingoes, hornbills and pelicans. The Manyara ecosystem consists of savannah, acacia woodland dotted with fig trees, swamps, hot springs and open grass plains. Certainly this makes Lake Manyara incredible diverse and the perfect place to see the spectacular 400 meter high Rift Valley Escarpment.

Enjoy a day game viewing in Lake Manyara with picnic lunch. In the late afternoon your guide drives back to Arusha or drop off at airport or hotel
