Regions to discover

Lima

Situated on the Edge of the Ocean, Lima was known as the Pacific Pearl. In the pre-hispanic time, the Valley where Peru's capital is located was a greenery oasis, which allowed the agricultural exploitation like fishing activity. During the 17th and 18th century, various colonial houses with wonderful balconies were built, as a symbol of Lima's political, strategical and economical importance. Discovering Lima nowadays is guessing at each corner of the streets the complexity of this huge city. Peru is a country made of contrasts, fighting to bring together, on the one hand the traditions of the rural society and on the other hand, the adaptation to modernity and the worldwide industrialization. Lima is an overpopulated city with more than 10 millions inhabitants and most of them come from inside the country, With its lacks and disorder, Lima is nevertheless a charming city. The friendly and festive Limenian invites you to discover it.



Cusco

The Cusco region must be one of the most interesting in south America for its rich past and its ancestral traditions. Its rich historical patrimony and geographical contrast will satisfy all kind of curious explorers. Nowadays, the entire Cusco region economically depends on agriculture and tourism. Cusco is the seventh most populated city in Peru. Near Cusco is the Urubamba Valley, better known as the Sacred Valley of the Incas which was a military, religious, political and agricultural centre during Inca times. Many fortresses were built on the flanks of the mountains, and these fortresses controlled access to the valley and protected it from invaders. Pisac and Ollantaytambo are considered the most important fortresses in the Sacred Valley. Further from the Sacred Valley, at 2,900 m.a.s.l., the majestic sanctuary-city of Machupicchu – the lost city of the Incas – is built atop the mountain and surrounded by tropical vegetation.



Sacred Valley

The sacred Valley is located about 10 miles from Cusco as the crow flies, but 1 800 feet below. Its pleasant climate and its fertile soil made the Urubamba Valley a choice granary for the Empire. It was also a strategic site because it guarded the entrance of the jungle. But above all, it was of course a high religious place. The place emanates a singular energy, a strange mix of sweet and relaxed lifestyle and a startling relief, stuck between a grandiose and impressive past, and a harsh present, rural and colored.



Machu Picchu

The visit of Machu Picchu can be as impressing as the visit of the Pyramids in Egypt... You have to imagine out from the postcard and open the eyes to the reality of being in this mystical site. The beginning of the visit is quite promising already with the surrounding landscape before getting there. Even before getting to the entrance the site remains hidden as a secret. The citadel is deemed one of the world's finest examples of landscape architecture. It is split into two major areas: the agricultural zone, made up of terracing and food storehouses; and the urban zone, featuring the sacred sector, with temples, squares and royal tombs which have been carved to an extraordinary degree of perfection. The stone staircases and canals are found throughout this unique archaeological site.



Titicaca

Ancient land of the Quechuas, Aymaras, Uros, Pacajes and Puqinas, the Titilaca Lake was considered as the cradle of the most influent pre-hispanic cultures in the Andes. From the 9th century, various independent kings arose that competed against each other until the middle of the 15th century, when the Incas conquered this region. The region was very important for the Incas regarding the production of wool and meat. Nowadays, in the region of Puno, the agricultural exploitation and ancestral rites as for instance offerings to the land are still very present. In 1978 the Titicaca Lake Reserve was created with the goal of preserving its fauna and flora and the beauty of its landscapes. In this reserve, 60 types of birds, 14 species of native fishes and 18 species of amphibians, between which the giant frog of the Lake that can reach 3 kg, were registered.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1:Lima

Reception at the arrival of your international flight at Jorge Chavez airport in Lima and transfer to the hotel.

An english representative will greet you at the airport and hand you over your travel documents.

Night at the Casa Republica boutique hotel in republica superior room

Included: private transport , arrival transfer with english-speaking guide , room & breakfast



Day 2:Lima- Cusco- Pisac- Sacred Valley- Urubamba

Transfer from your hotel to the Lima airport.

Flight to Cusco.

Morning departure by private vehicle for an excursion to explore the Sacred Valley.

The first stop will be the ruins of Pisac where we will visit the site and walk around the handicraft market.

Return to your hotel in the Sacred Valley.

Arrival at the Chaska Ocupi **glamping** site in the heart of the Sacred Valley mountains, where you will spend the night. Take advantage of this unusual experience to reconnect with nature while enjoying very comfortable facilities.

Each tent is equipped with twin beds, heating and has a private bathroom and terrace.

Included: private transport , departure transfer , airport tax , domestic flight , guide expenses , english speaking guide , entrance fees mentioned in the program , room & breakfast



Day 3:Sacred Valley- Moray- Maras- Chinchero- Sacred Valley- Urubamba

Departure at 9am in a private vehicle on a day-trip exploring the Sacred Valley.

The first stop will be at the cultural site of Moray, an ancient Inca agricultural laboratory.

We take to the road again, this time in the direction of the salt flats of Maras, located in the middle of the Cordillera.

Then we head on to the colonial town of Chinchero where we will eat lunch in a local family's home and then visit the colonial church and adjoining ruins before making the return journey to your hotel in the Sacred Valley.

Night at the Chaska Ocupi **glamping** site in the heart of the Sacred Valley mountains.

Included: private transport , entrance fees mentioned in the program , english speaking guide , guide expenses , lunch (no drinks) , room & breakfast



Day 4: Sacred Valley- Ollantaytambo- Aguas Calientes- Machu Picchu- Aguas Calientes- Ollantaytambo- Cusco

Transfer in private vehicle to Ollantaytambo's train station.
First class train to Aguas Calientes.

*Note: The train company allows passengers to carry a **cabin bag of up to 8 kg** per person. It will be necessary to leave your "checked" luggage at the deposit of the hotel in the Sacred Valley and Cusco.*



Morning train.

Direct connection to the shuttle service that will drive you to the citadel of Machu Picchu.

Departures, for the ascent and as well as the descent, run every 5 minutes.

Note: 1st shuttle to the citadel: 05:30am / Duration: 30 minutes

Last Shuttle to the citadel: 3:30pm / Last Shuttle to Aguas Calientes: 4:45pm

Your guide accompanies you on the bus from Aguas Calientes to Machu Picchu.
Arrival on the site of Machu Picchu, wonder of the world.

Machu Picchu is an ancient Inca city of the fifteenth century in Peru. Abandoned during the collapse of the Inca empire, the sacred city of the Incas, was forgotten for centuries. It is considered as a masterpiece of the architecture of this civilization. It was unveiled by the American archaeologist Hiram Bingham in 1911.

In 1983, Machu Picchu was declared UNESCO World Heritage List. On July 7, 2007, Machu Picchu was voted one of the New Seven Wonders of the World by the New Open World Foundation, an unofficial and commercial organization. Finally the site is part of a whole cultural and natural complex known as the "Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu".

Note 1 : 1st access to the site 6h, last access: 14h.

Entrance to Machu Picchu is regulated by a 3-hour slot on the site. We will communicate the entry schedule to the site that we recommend according to your program. After this confirmation, the schedule for entering the site cannot be changed.

Note 2 : Possibility to include the ascent of Huayna Picchu or Montaña Machu Picchu (these two climbs are subject to quotas and require early booking)

First class train to Ollantaytambo.

Note: The train company allows passengers to carry a cabin bag of up to 8kg per person. It will be necessary to leave your "checked" luggage at the deposit of the hotel in the Sacred Valley and Cusco.

Afternoon train.

Reception at Ollantaytambo's train station and transfer to the hotel in Cusco.
Night at the hotel El Mercado.

Included: private transport , train ticket , bus ticket , guide expenses , entrance fees mentioned in the program , english speaking guide , room & breakfast

Day 5: Cusco

Time-off in the morning to relax.

Departure for a half day dedicated to the discovery of Cuzco's historical downtown.

Walk through the picturesque streets and squares of the San Blas neighborhood. Visit the Qoricancha (Temple of the Sun), and the Cathedral which has many paintings and other treasures of goldsmithery, silver and precious stones.

Night at the hotel El Mercado.

Included: excursion (private) , english speaking guide , entrance fees mentioned in the program , room & breakfast



Day 6:Cusco- Andahuaylillas- Raqchi- Pukara- Puno

trip : 10:40hrs.

Transfer to Cusco's bus terminal.
English speaking assistance from hotel to bus terminal station.
At 6:50 am: Departure by tourist bus to Puno, a city located on the shores of Lake Titicaca.

This route allows you to enjoy superb landscapes all along the route, via the Col de la Raya, at an altitude of 4,320 meters.

We will stop first at Andahuaylillas to visit its church, nicknamed the Sistine Chapel of the Andes for its interior richness (murals superimposed over 3 centuries, paintings, carved and gilded altar with gold leaf, organ).

Lunch included (buffet restaurant in Marangani).

Second stop at Raqchi to visit the temple of Wiracocha.

Last stop in the village of Pukara, here we will visit the archaeological museum of Pukara before continuing on to Puno.

An English-speaking guide, exclusive to the bus company, participates to the journey and gives information along the way.

trip 10:40 hrs.

Reception at Puno bus station and transfer to the hotel.

Night at the hotel Posada del Inca Puno.
Room with lake view.

Included: private transport , departure transfer with english speaking guide , bus ticket , excursion (shared) , local english-speaking guide , lunch , entrance fees mentioned in the program , room & breakfast



Day 7:Puno- Uros- Llachon- Yunguyo

Departure at 07:00 am from the hotel to the port of Puno.

After 20 minutes on the boat, you will take a kayak and go for an 1 hour excursion on the Titicaca Lake. You will discover Uros Islands.

Then, you will continue to the boat trip to the Llachon peninsula (1h 30 of navigation) Once in Llachon you start walking about 3h to Paramis.

Lunch in Paramis.

In the afternoon you can choose between the following activities: demonstration of medicinal plants, preparation of a traditional dish of the community "Quispiño". You will have to opportunity to learn the traditional embroidery technics for hats

Dinner and overnight in homestay
Note: basic comfort in homestay

Day 8:Ccotos Peninsula- Puno- Yunguyo- Ccotos Peninsula- Puno

In the morning, small sailboat and artisanal fishing in Paramis.

Then you start walking around 2h00 to Ccotos.

Lunch at a homestay in Ccotos.

Return to Puno in the afternoon and transfert to the hotel.

Night at the hotel Posada del Inca Puno.

Room with lake view.

Included: breakfast , excursion (private) , english speaking guide , lunch (no drinks) , room & breakfast

Day 9:Puno- Juliaca- Lima

Private transfer from the hotel to Juliaca's airport.

Domestic flight to Lima.

Reception at the airport and transfer to the hotel.

Day 10:Lima

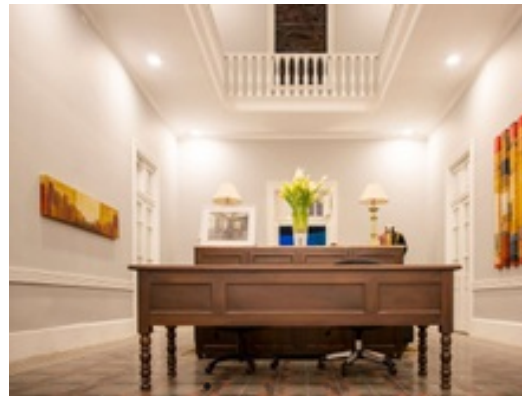
