Dolomites- Snowshoes experience

Clip on **snowshoes** and embark upon an adventure immersed in the snow-white nature that surrounds small villages of. Snowshoes are ideal for **winter excursions in the mountains**. Wander through the woods nestled among the Dolomites. Take hikes along unexplored trails within hidden valleys or stay on marked trails. **Discover the silence of the woods veiled by snow**

Snow - Nature - Silence: these are the reasons that accompany the **snowshoeing** enthusiasts or simply those who want to walk through the woods of our valley . There are **various routes** for those who want to spend a few hours in the **silence of the woods**.

Some are beaten by snow cat and other uncontaminated by a soft blanket of fresh snow. **Easy walks** suitable for families with children who prefer short trips, or more challenging tracks that lead hikers at the foot of **Mount Pelmo , Lastoi del Formin or at the Monte Fertazza**. During the winter snowshoe walks are organized both in the light of the sun to the moon, also you can rent snowshoes and all the equipment in the stores that are located in the valley.

The two floodlit slopes of the **5 km long**, are served by a gondola to 12 seats, offering the opportunity for expert skiers, to experience the thrill of the slope even when the sun is down .



Optional: Dolomites - Ski tour "The Great war"

The ski tour of the Great War winds around the Mount Col di Lana notorious for the bloody battles that were fought there during the First World War and traces the Dolomite front where a hundred years ago we fought the Italian army and the Austro-Hungarian Empire. The tour passes through the areas **of Civetta - 5 Torri / Lagazuoi - Alta Badia - Arabba Marmolada**.

Starting from **Selva di Cadore** it goes to Fedare with the **Ski bus**, from there continue towards **the Lagazuoi** from where you can admire a 360 ° panorama of the Dolomites. Descend to the beautiful slope of **Armentarola** and go through all the **Alta Badia** until you reach **Arabba**. **Portavescovo** taken the cable car, walk down to Malga Ciapela, here for those who want you can go up to **the Marmolada the highest peak in the Dolomites**. The descent down the glacier to the slope La Bellunese, the longest of the entire **Dolomiti Superski** brings to **Malga Ciapela**.



Optional: Dolomites - Ski Mountaineering

Discover the winter charm, in the recent years the practice **of ski touring** has increased more and more the number of practitioners. Those who choose this discipline **loves free and open spaces**, worn the equipping and the ski the pleasure of ski touring and **the downhill thrill** allow you to make fantastic excursions. **There are many itineraries** some easier that wind through the woods of the valley other more challenging like to climb the **Corvo Alto or Monte Pore** or along the scree **of Pelmo until Forca Rossa**. Dolomites area - Woodcrafting

The creation of wood-carved figures is a century old tradition in Val Gardena which harks back to the long winter nights, during which people fantasized and tried to give wooden blocks a shape with rudimentary objects. At the same time carving was an opportunity to give shape to individual impressions, beliefs and life stances. Masks and everyday items were the most carved, followed by wooden toys and religious figures, which only testified to the improved technique and the achieved artistic finesse of carvers.

What had started as a small endeavour around 1600 had become a main trade at the end of the 18th century for many people in this Dolomite valley. The establishment of an art and design school, the construction of the road of Val Gardena as well as the establishment of a sales cooperative all contributed to the overall improvement in the valley. The carved and exported objects were mostly Christian figures, such as representations of Mary, angels, crucifixes and nativity scenes.



Dolomites - Christmas markets

Christmas markets in Trentino Alto Adige are a deeply felt tradition: every year, between the end of November and January 6, the festive atmosphere of mountain towns and villages gets further enhanced by the '*mercatini di Natale*', filled with local crafts, decorations, and food stands offering typical holiday fare. Many villages set up nativity scenes as well. **Gourmet stands** offer local specialties such as *polenta brustolada* (grilled polenta) and *canederli* (bread dumplings), as well as *vin brulè* (mulled wine).
