## Wednesday, January 4<sup>th</sup> 2023

Arrival in Venice airport private transfer to hotel

 $\circ~$  After customs meet your private concierge and together reach the pier to take your private boat to your hotel.

## Thursday, January 5<sup>th</sup> 2023

Private boat tour to Murano Island (4 hours) – early afternoon gondola ride

- 30 minutes private gondola ride

## Murano Island: The Wonders of Murano Glass

It is not exactly known when glass making began, however it was confined to Murano by a law passed in 1291. Since then, Murano glass has been known all over the world for its craftsmanship, imagination, creativity and originality. Just as it has been done for centuries, Murano glass is still made by hand with a team of artisans known as a "piazza" who work around the glass master seated in his "scagno" as he directs and works the glass with his team. Your guide will pick you up at the hotel with a private boat and will take you to Murano to see how this famous glass is made. Your

assistant will lead you behind the doors of the various glass masters' studios where you will have the opportunity to see how the different techniques are used to make sculptures, drinking glasses and chandeliers. Then you will visit a factory showroom where you can order and purchase customized pieces at whole sale prices, all with the guarantee that you are buying **hand-made Murano glass.** 

In the early afternoon You'll also enjoy your awaiting Gondola. The magic of this unique city will come alive as you glide by gondola down the shimmering Grand Canal and float quietly down inner canals spanned by tiny romantic bridges - you will get lost in this beautiful labyrinth of land and water. Taking a gondola ride in Venice gives you a completely different perspective of the city than exploring it on foot. They have been a tradition in Venice for centuries. Initially used to transport goods down the narrow canals of Venice, today gondolas are primarily used for sightseeing and ceremonial functions.

## Friday, January 6th 2023

Private walking guided tour of St Mark's Square (3 hours) – afternoon Hidden Venice tour

- Golden Basilica and Doge's Palace entrance fees are included

## St Mark's Square

The guide will meet you for the walking tour that explains the historical background of Venice. While visiting St. Mark's square, with the **Golden Basilica** (inside) and the **Doge's palace** (inside), you will see some of the most admired and well-known monuments and architectural jewels. The Doge's Palace is a masterpiece of Gothic architecture with vast council chambers and delicately decorated residential apartments. The interior is filled with works by artists such as Titian, Veronese, Tintoretto, Vittoria and Tiepolo. Finally, you will have a short walk to the **Bridge of Sights** that connects Palazzo Ducale to the 16th-century Priggione Nove (New Prisons). Its improbable popularity is due to British libertine Lord Byron (1788–1824), who mentioned it in one of his long narrative poems Childe Harold's Pilgrimage. Condemned prisoners were said to sigh as they passed through the enclosed bridge and glimpsed the beauty of the lagoon. Now the sighs are mainly from people trying to dodge the picture-snapping masses!

After a leisurely lunch continue your tour with your English speaking guide to discover the hidden Venice on a 2 hour guided tour of Hidden Venice, to explore the fascinating but lesser know alleyways and narrow streets not far from San Marco. You can admire the churches and monuments that testify to the long tradition of the Venetian history and culture, seeing the many different architectural styles that have evolved over the centuries, from late Byzantine to Gothic, from Lombard to Renaissance through to Baroque.

## Friday, January 6<sup>th</sup> 2023

The long-time center of the powerful Roman Empire, Rome boasts nearly 3,000 years of architecture, history, and culture. These days, Italy's capital is considered one of Europe's top cities thanks to its ancient monuments, incredible art masterpieces, and cosmopolitan vibe. It's a center for fashion with buzzing food culture and has a growing nightlife scene.

Visitors and locals wanting to soak in the sunshine flock to the beautiful Giardino degli Aranci, the city's vibrant orange tree gardens on Aventine Hill, or relax in the lush greenery of the Villa Borghese Gardens.

The Amphitheater created to entertain ancient Roman citizens with bloody shows of gladiators, animals and cruel games, is now one of the most fascinating landmarks of the City. Then, walk on the original path of ancient Rome along the Via Sacra and see the Temples of Vesta, Antonino and Faustina, the ancient Basilica Julia and Aemilia and dream about the glorious past of the Roman Empire. Unforgettable!

## Sunday, January 8th 2023

Rome - Pompeii – Rome

Set off today for your new amazing experience and enjoy a visit to the fantastic ruins of **Pompeii** Upon arrival you will be met by your local English-speaking tour guide for 2 hours visit. This fascinating historical site now provides us with a rich history of life at the time of the Roman Empire. You will have the chance to see how the **ancient Romans** lived and admire the level of civic progress and artistic skills they had reached so many years ago. After the fall of the **Roman Empire,** such levels of progress were only reached in the 17th and 18th century. Enjoy leisurely lunch up to 1 hour (payable locally) before returning to Rome.

## Monday, January 9th 2023

Rome – Florence – Rome

- Meet your driver at your hotel and proceed to Rome train station and return

- Private guide in Florence for 3 hrs

After a leisurely breakfast meet your driver and head towards the Rome train station to catch the train to Florence

Upon arrival at the Florence Santa maria Novella train station meet your private English-speaking guide and commence your 3 hours guided tour of the city

Today you will get the chance to have a wonderful overview of Florence; not just the cradle of the Renaissance but showcasing 2000 years of history. The city's Roman origins are still very much in evidence of its grid pattern of streets. The tour will start at the **Duomo**, in the very heart of the city. Here you will see the **Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore**, with Brunelleschi's dome (the first to be built since the Pantheon in Rome) the Baptistery with Ghiberti's legendary bronze doors and Giotto's great Campanile. A short walk from here will bring you to the **Piazza della Signoria**, the political heart of the city. The square is dominated by the **Palazzo Vecchio**, begun in 1299, to house the Signoria, the highest tier of the city's republican government. Standing in front of it is a copy of Michelangelo's David, for this is the space it was designed to occupy, the symbol of the power of the city. By the end of the tour, you should have a solid idea of the history of the city.
