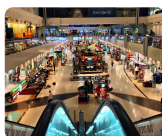

Inscribed on **UNESCO's World Heritage List** is **Valletta** with its 320 historic monuments situated within a concentrated area of 55 hectare. It was ruled successively by the Phoenicians, Greeks, Carthaginians, Romans, Byzantines, Arabs and the Order of the Knights of St John. It is inextricably linked to the history of the military and charitable Order of St John of Jerusalem. Today, you will visit to the Grand Master's Palace. After that explore in the impressive St John's Co-Cathedral and the National Museum of Archaeology.

Cruise along the rugged coastline to reach the Crystal and Blue lagoons with their turquoise waters and ideal swimming and snorkeling spots. Then explore the island of Gozo on your own or with a private guide to see its key landmarks and cities such as Victoria and Xlendi before heading back to Malta.

Malta - Hypogeum of Hal Saflieni Optional tour (Not included)

The Hal Saflieni Hypogeum is located in Paola, about 5 km away from Valletta, and is the only underground prehistoric temple in the world. It was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and its construction dates back to 3600 BC.

More than 7,000 skeletons have been found here: the hypogeum was discovered by chance in 1902 after some work and is worth a visit because it goes down three levels underground. The first level is the oldest; the second conceals many rooms, including the Main Room, where the famous statuette of the Sleeping Woman and the Oracle Room were found: in this room there is a hole from which the voice of a man (but not a woman)) manages to make itself heard throughout the hypogeum. All the rooms on the level, including the ceilings, are decorated and painted. The third level does not contain bones and therefore is thought to have served as a deposit of wheat.

Malta - optional tour (Not included)

- POPEYE VILLAGE

It is a theme park, also known by the name of Sweethaven Village, located in the bay of Anchor, in the northwest corner of the island, just 3 km from the village of Mellieha. In 1980 a film set was produced here for the production of the Hollywood film Popeye-Popeye (played by the late Robin Williams). Once the shooting was over, the village remained and it was transformed into a sort of open-air museum. It remains today and is a highly recommended destination for families with children or simply for lovers of entertainment parks. The park consists of 19 colorful wooden houses, naturally themed with the famous cartoon.

Inside you can make trips and attend shows, such as the puppet show. There is also space for museums (some houses keep interesting objects and articles from the filming) and to attractions of different kinds. For example, there are areas where children can climb or meet entertainers disguised as cult characters from the cartoon, namely Popeye, Olivia, Bluto and Poldo. Furthermore, in the center of Popeye Village there is the Lower Complex, a cinema hall (capacity of 40 seats) where you can see videos of about twenty minutes that tell the story of the park.

- FOOD TOUR

The cuisine of Malta is a treasure trove of Mediterranean influences and flavors and is affected by the proximity of Italy and Africa and of all the populations that have passed through here. It is difficult to choose a representative dish: with this tour you will test some of the most famous dishes.

Among the local delights you can find **pastizzi**, small savory puffs stuffed with ricotta or peas: they are eaten at all hours and the best ones are sold on the street, freshly cooked. **Fish** reigns supreme in the Maltese archipelago, always fresh: in Malta you can taste **Aljota**, a soup made with garlic and fresh fish. Among the earthen dishes the local **rabbit** served with tomato and potatoes gives life to **fenkata**, the most famous dish. Do not miss the **zazzett**, pork sausages flavored with coriander, and the timpana, a tasty timbale of baked pasta with mixed meat enclosed in puff pastry. Malta is also famous for its **cheeses and sweets**: Malta's most renowned cheese is **Gbejnet**, made from sheep's milk. It is natural, fresh or seasoned or enriched with pepper and aromatic herbs. Among the most delicious desserts we find the **Kanoli**, very similar to the Sicilian cannoli with ricotta and chocolate chips, and the **Qaghaq tal-ghasel**, a dessert of Arab origin with black sugar, figs and cinnamon. The Maltese drink par excellence is Cisk beer, a local blonde beer; if you want to end the meal with a typical liqueur, ask for the prickly pear or carob one.

- TOUR OF PREHISTORIC TEMPLES

Go back in time and visit Malta's prehistoric temples dating back to 3150 BC. Tour the megalithic temples of Hagar Qim and Mnajdra with an expert guide and discover the works of art engraved in stone. Visit the ancient cave of Ghar Dalam.

- LOCAL MARKETS TOUR

One of the main attractions of Malta are the local markets. It's a great way to see local customs. In Malta there are several outdoor markets, where you can enjoy the typically Mediterranean flavors and aromas. In the villages between the island of Malta and Gozo, local markets take place a few times a week that offer artisan products, culinary, textile and much more.

- JEEP 4X4 EXPERIENCE IN GOZO ISLAND

Explore the island of Gozo by jeep, on a day tour from Malta. Discover the places of interest and hidden corners of Gozo, aboard a jeep that can travel through small country roads, where larger vehicles cannot venture. Visit the main attractions such as Victoria, Belvedere Qala, UNESCO World Heritage Site, the temples of Ggantija, along with many other destinations for the whole island.

May 3 - Day 4 Malta



Malta - best beaches

Malta is known for having some of the best beaches in the Mediterranean. A few beaches are Blue Flag certified, which means such beaches adhere to standards for sustainable development, environmental management, safety and other services.

- **Ġnejna** is a rare little gem of a beach on the West coast of Malta, which is sandy and fairly secluded and not very popular among tourists as a result. It's good proof that being a little more adventurous and exploring your holiday location can pay off.

- **Paradise Bay** is located near Ċirkewwa in the Northern most part of Malta, where the ferry to the neighbouring island of Gozo departs. The beach is set in a natural cove and is quite secluded and peaceful, surrounded by high cliffs, with great views of its rugged landscape and of the nearby islands of Gozo and of Comino.

- **The Blue Lagoon** is a stunningly beautiful inlet on the small island of Comino. It is sheltered and has dazzlingly azure waters. Access to this fascinating inlet is by boat trip from Gozo or Malta. There are two white sand beaches, one on either side of the crystal clear water: the bottom of the inlet also consists of white sand.

The rest of the bay is rocky: here visitors can sunbathe or jump into the refreshing water. Snorkelling is popular due to the clarity of the water as well as the presence of several caves. No boats are allowed, so it is an especially peaceful setting.

- **St. Peter's Pool** is a pool-shaped bay on the East coast of Malta, nearby the fisherman's village of Marsaxlokk. There's no beach as such, although there's enough room to spread out your beach towel on the flat rocky surface around the bay.

- Not very easy to reach but well worth the trouble getting there, **Imġiebaħ Bay** is a little gem that's undisturbed by man. A small sandy beach is surrounded by the rocky shore and although small in size, it rarely gets busy here. It's located in the North of Malta.

- **Mellieħa Bay** (also referred to locally as Għadira Bay) is the largest sandy beach on Malta and one of the best beaches in the Mediterranean. It is by far one of the most popular of Malta's beaches and with a surf that remains shallow for a good distance out and easy access, this spot is a firm favourite for families with children.

- **Golden Bay** is located on the Northwest coast of Malta, right next to Għajn Tuffieħa (the next beach on the list) and is a popularly visited beach which was one of the first to earn Blue Flag status.

- **Għajn Tuffieħa** is one of the favourite beach in Malta, with some of the best scenery and sea you'll encounter around the Maltese islands. This beach is a perfect balance between being in raw nature and yet having facilities to be comfortable at the beach.

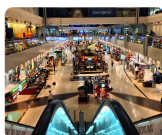

You will admire the beautiful array of jewelry, sculpture, and tableware, then you will pick out your favorite one to purchase as a souvenir. Afterward, you will enjoy a picturesque and leisurely walk to the 12th century Cathedral of Saints Maria e Donato and step inside to see beautiful Romanic architecture and a well-preserved mosaic.

Optional tour: Today you will meet your persona guide to enjoy a charming private boat tour of the islands of the most famous islands of the Venetian lagoon. **Murano, Burano and Torcello**, known all over the world for their characteristic landscape, craftsmanship and history. **Murano**, famous by its 700 century-old tradition of **blown glass** art. Here you will observe a glassblower create a work of art before your very eyes. You will continue to visit **Burano**, famous for the **lace making** and its **colorful fishermen's houses**. You will then visit **Torcello**, a true jewel of the Venetian lagoon with the oldest church in the whole area: the **Basilica of Santa Maria Assunta** with its Byzantine mosaic.

Optional tour: This morning, your guide will wait for you at the hotel lobby. The *squero* is a typical Venetian shipyard where small boats such as gondolas, pupparini, sandoli, sciopòni and other boats typical of the Venetian lagoon tradition are created, built and repaired. During the visit you will be shown the characteristics of these particular Venetian boats and the processing techniques. Lo *squerarolo* works by hand as in the past, without the support of written projects and customizing each boat tailored to the buyer. Each master has his own secrets.

Optional activity: Rowing lesson - Today you will learn the basic stroke for rowing in the bow. You will attend a demonstration and then you will try it too, with the boat still moored. You will depart, with each rower taking turns and getting acclimated to the stroke as we glide along a wide, quiet canal. You will cross into the expansive, open lagoon, where you will be encouraged to try rowing a poppa — steering the boat yourself at the stern, just like a gondolier. Then, you will return back through the evocative side canals back to the drop-off point. You will have you the possibility to experience the rich heritage of this unique rowing style first-hand!

Optional tour: Today you will enter the heart of the most authentic Venice; one of the last artisan shops, where a master mask maker works papier-mâché according to the ancient traditions of masked masters of the 1300s. You will enjoy a **carnival mask workshop** (made of papier-mâché) where you will be able to unleash your creativity and live a unique experience, fully immersing yourself in the centuries-old tradition of Venetian artisans, whose works of art are known and appreciated all over the world.

Optional activity: In the evening you will attend an **opera show** at Palazzo Barbarigo - Minotto . It will be an unique operatic experience in the rooms of the 17th century **Palazzo Barbarigo - Minotto**, a beautiful Grand Canal mansion in San Marco. The palace is quite spectacular with six state rooms which are enriched in the first half of the 1700s by artists whose importance is still recognized today.

Optional activity: Journey through the life and work of one of the world's great artists and inventors at the **Leonardo da Vinci Museum** in Venice.

Optional activity: Make your stay in Venice memorable by visiting the **La Fenice Opera House**. enjoy a real Opera in the one of the best theatre in the world. Ask for shows season

Optional activity: This morning you will enjoy a visit at the **Peggy Guggenheim Collection** on the Grand Canal of Venice. The Peggy Guggenheim Collection is the personal collection of the legendary patron of the arts Peggy Guggenheim., a niece of Solomon R. Guggenheim. It includes major holdings of Cubism, Abstraction, Surrealism, early American Abstract Expressionism, and postwar European and American painting and sculpture. Artists comprise masterpieces by Jean Arp, Umberto Boccioni, Alexander Calder, Marcel Duchamp, Max Ernst, **René Magritte**, **Joan Miró**, **Pablo Picasso**, Jackson Pollock, Germaine Richier, Gino Severini, Clyfford Still, and Emilio Vedova, among others.

It is possible to organise also a private visit and a a special (romantic) dinner at the museum after the closing time.

Optional activity: Get an impressive view of Venice and its network of canals from the top of the famous spiral staircase of the **Palazzo Contarini del Bovolo**.

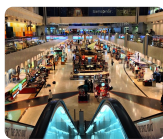
