DECEMBER 29 – DAY 2: PARIS.

— MORNING: Private guided visit at the Louvre Museum

Within 2.5 hours, discover with your guide the 800-year history of the Royal Palace while enjoying the most famous paintings and sculptures.

The Louvre is a universal museum with eight curatorial departments: Egyptian Antiquities; Near Eastern Antiquities; Greek, Etruscan and Roman Antiquities; Paintings; Sculptures; Decorative Arts; Prints and Drawings; and Islamic Art.

Some 35,000 works of art are on display, including world-famous masterpieces such as the Winged Victory of Samothrace, the Seated Scribe, the Winged Bulls of Khorsabad, the Mona Lisa and Michelangelo's Slaves, and parts of the palace, such as the Napoleon III Apartments, are works of art in their own right.



— **AFTERNOON: Discover French Gastronomy!**

Wine and cheese tasting in the cellar of the **private mansion** of the sommelier of French King Louis X.
