TRIP IN SEPTEMBER 2023

Avignon, a city in southeastern France's Provence region, is set on the **Rhône River**. From 1309 to 1377, it was the seat of the **Catholic popes**. It remained under papal rule until becoming part of France in 1791. This legacy can be seen in the massive **Palais des Papes** (**Popes' Palace**) in the city center, which is surrounded by medieval stone ramparts.



Then you will visit the Belgian city of **Arles**, a city on the **Rhône River** in the Provence region of southern France. It's famed for inspiring the **paintings of Van Gogh**, which influenced the contemporary art displayed at the Fondation Vincent Van Gogh. Once a provincial capital of **ancient Rome**, Arles is also known for many remains from that era, including **Arles Amphitheatre** (**les Arènes d'Arles**), now hosting **plays**, **concerts and bullfights**.



Don't miss **Aix-en Provence**, well known for its musical heritage – it boasts one of the best conservatoires (music schools) in the country. It also has a thriving music and festival scene, from the eight-day festival of free concerts, Musique dans la Rue, to the annual free opera concert on Cours Mirabeau.





In Roman times one of the richest towns of Gaul, **Nîmes** is famous for its many Roman remains, which are mostly in an excellent state of preservation. The vast amphitheatre, probably built in the 1st century ce to seat 24,000, is an ellipse (440 by 330 feet [135 by 100 metres]), standing 69 feet (21 metres) high.



Louis XIV (ruled 1643–1715) made **Montpellier** the administrative capital of the Languedoc region, famous for its wines. The modern city is a tourist center and the seat of the International Vine and Wine Fair. Its industries include food processing, metallurgy, electronics, pharmaceuticals, and textile weaving.



End the trip in **Carcassonne**. After the settlements at the foot of the city were destroyed, King St Louis authorised the local inhabitants to build a new town in 1245. This became known as the Bastide Saint Louis. Today, Carcassonne is renowned across the globe thanks to its two UNESCO World Heritage sites, the Medieval City and the Canal du Midi.





SEPTEMBER 5 - DAY 1: WELCOME TO FRANCE!

- AFTERNOON: Self-guided Visit to Musée Du Petit Palais

The Musée du Petit Palais is a museum and art gallery in Avignon, southern France. It opened in 1976 and has an exceptional collection of Renaissance paintings of the Avignon school as well as from Italy, which reunites many "primitives" from the collection of Giampietro Campana.



See Roman buildings and bridges, including the magnificent **Amphithèatre** and the **Temple of Diane.** Explore the city considered the center of Roman culture in Europe.

- AFTERNOON: Vers-Pont-du-Gard from Nimes

Drive from Nimes to Vers-Pont-du-Gard. Vers-Pont-du-Gard is a small, Medieval village built from the orange-ochre limestone that's been quarried in the area since **Roman times**. The village has three ancient, covered lavoirs, a medieval tower with a lovely old campanile, and an active village life with shops that are open even on Sundays.

- AFTERNOON: The Châteaux of Grès de Montpellier & Wine Tasting

During the tour you will visit **château de Flaugergues**, a sumptuous bourgeoisie summer house dating back to 17th century, before tasting their excellent range of wines. You will then visit the famous **Château Puech Haut**, settled in beautiful surroundings in the middle of vineyards and olive trees. You can admire a unique and original exhibition of painted oak barrels.

through the streets of the ancient religious quarter and learn about the inquisition in Carcassonne and Toulouse.

Duration: 2 Hours / Private Guided Tour



- AFTERNOON: Free Time at Carcassonne

You can explore the city of Carcassonne and discover the cathedrals. Stay a little longer to enjoy a breathtaking sunset in Carcassonne.
