September 12 - Day 2 Five Lands



Cinque Terre (Five Lands) - Private guided tour

This morning you will enjoy a tour of the breathtaking Five Lands. You will meet your private guide in Riomaggiore, to depart by ferry boat/train for an unforgettable day dedicated to the discovery of one of the most amazing and enchanting landscape in the world. The Five Lands, "Cinque Terre" is an area suspended between sea and land, hanging from sheer cliffs surrounded by hills and vineyards. You will enter into a little piece of heaven. By touring the coast line by boat, you will have the possibility to admire this amazing landscape from the seaside, like in a postcard. During the tour, you will see the most important villages: Riomaggiore, caught between two steep terraced hills descending in steep cliffs to the sea, the ancient village of Riomaggiore strikes visitors with its delightfully colored houses built vertically; Manarola, built on a high rock 70 metres above sea level, is one of the most charming and romantic villages; Vernazza, a small fishing village, the most characteristic of the Cinque Terre.

September 13 - Day 3 Five Lands - Pisa - Lucca - Tuscany Countryside



Pisa - private guided tour

This morning your personal driver will take you to Pisa where you will meet your personal guide and you will start your tour with a walk alongside the Medieval walls up to the entrance gate: Porta Santa Maria. From here you will see a unique panorama of **Piazza dei Miracoli** with its marble architecture and neat grass lawns. You will visit the interiors of the Cathedral a masterpiece of Romanesque art. Besides the Tower, Piazza dei Miracoli houses other buildings of historic artistic value such as the Baptistery and the Monumental Graveyard. At the end you will climb one of the most celebrated monuments in the world: **The Leaning Tower**.

Lucca - Private guided tour

Before reachin Tuscany countryside you will visit **Lucca**, which is the only old town in Italy entirely surrounded by walls which are still very well preserved. Visit the **San Frediano church**, with its magnificent thirteenth-century mosaic representing Christ in Majesty. Then, explore the **Piazza del Anfiteatro**, the most beautiful square of Lucca passing by elegant shops of **Via Filungo** through small medieval streets. End in the **Duomo** which houses the famous Volto Santo and the splendid llaria del Caretto sarcophagus, a masterpiece of Jacopo della Quercia. Passing **Piazza Napoleone**, we finally arrive at **Piazza San Michele**, the central civic square of Lucca since Roman times.

September 14 - Day 4 Tuscany Countryside



Tuscany Countryside - Private guided tour of Pienza, Montalcino and Montepulciano

This morning private transfer to **Montepulciano**, one of the most characteristic and intact medieval cities in Italy which, from a height of 605 meters above sea level, offers amazing views over the surrounding hillsides. You will explore the wonderful town center of Montepulciano. Continue the drive to a vineyard for a wine taste and lunch.

Enjoy a day of culture, wine, and food as you visit some of the most impressive towns and villages in Tuscany. Go to the picturesque town of **Pienza**, and taste world-famous wines produced in **Montalcino** and **Montepulciano**.

Cross gently rolling hills full of vineyards, and then sample local wines served with a delicious snack of the local produce. Explore the streets of **Montalcino** to experience a typical Tuscan village and its fortress. Continue to **Pienza** to discover the "Touchstone of Renaissance Urbanism." Considered an artistic jewel of the landscape of **Val d'Orcia**, Pienza is a perfect combination of architectural beauty and harmony. Most of the lanes bearing impressive names overlook the breathtaking landscape of the Val d'Orcia. Unique smells and flavors are entwined with this natural and artistic heritage. Pienza's most renowned tradition is pecorino cheese. End the tour at **Montepulciano**, where the stateliness of its Renaissance buildings and the refined beauty of the town's churches mix with the ancient tradition of wine making.

Tuscany Countryside - Private guided tours of Siena & San Gimignano

Chianti - wine tasting with lunch
