The city of Chania is built on the area of Minoan Kidonia, at the end of the homonym gulf between Akrotiri and Onicha peninsulas. It was the former capital city of Crete (from 1847 until 1972). Nowadays, it is the second-largest city of Crete after Heraklion and the capital of the homonym prefecture.

Get familiar with the city of Chania by wandering around in its streets, visiting its museums, and admiring the different architectural styles presenting the historical route of the city.

Halepa And Tabakaria Private Walking Tour

Private group · 2.5 hours

One of the most important and historical places in Chania is the Halepa area. The noblemen and kings' neighborhood will surprise you with the 19th and 20th-century historical facts. You will walk around beautiful buildings and admire the miracle of the past centuries' architecture.

Today, Halepa, with its imposing mansions and luxury villas, is considered the aristocratic neighborhood of Chania. Eleftherios Venizelos's house, one of the most important Greek politicians in Halepa, is famous as the scene of the most important political events in the 19th century. It was the site of the High Commissioner's palace, i.e. the governor of semi-autonomous Crete during the time of the Independent Cretan State. Here also were located the consulates of the Great Powers during the same period.

You will walk by the old buildings of the "great school of diplomacy" and the French nuns' School (girls) San Joseph guild. On Dagli Street is Agia Magdalini church (St Mary Magdalene), built in the Russian style. The church was built by Prince George of Greece in 1901-1903, when he was High Commissioner of Crete, with funds he brought from Russia. The church stands out due to its architectural style and Russian dome. There locates in the new archaeological museum of Chania, an imposing modern building with terrific historical exhibits.

Halepa is also known for its big factories of leathers and the port of fishers, Tabakaria area, with magnificent fish taverns. Optional tavern visit at the end of the tour.

The cradle of the Minoan civilization.

Heraklion is the largest city of Crete and one of Greece's major urban centers. The city flourished under a multicultural influence throughout the centuries; that's why there is a plethora of Byzantine, Venetian, and Ottoman structures to look out for!

The city's landmark is the 16th c. Koules fortress in the westernmost side of the old Venetian port, which along with the fortification walls (dating back to the same period) are among the most significant and imposing sights.

What to see in Heraklion:

Start your visit at the old Venetian port where you can see the vaulted tarsands (shipyard) where ships used to be built during the Middle ages. On its west, you can't miss the 16th c. Koule Fortress whose first walls were built by the Arabs and were later reinforced by the Venetians in the 15th century. The Martinengo bastion, the only one out of seven that is preserved today, is where the renowned writer N. Kazantzakis' tomb is located and overlooks the city. The are only 2 out of 4 entrances to the city that still stand and you can see, Chanioporta (1570) Gate with its marble relief winged Lion of Saint-Marc and the New Gate (1587) on the south side of the fortress.

In the heart of the city, there are many monuments dating back to the Middle Ages, a period in which Heraklion witnessed great prosperity. From the port, ascending 25 Avgoustou (August) street, you will reach the public square, where the church of Agios Titos is found built in 1872 on the site where a Byzantine church once stood. Next to it lies the 16th c. Venetian Loggia, a Venetian building with ornate arcades and walls, sculptures, etc. that served as a meeting place for the Duke and other noblemen during the Venetian period.

Don't miss Heraklion's Venetian and Turkish fountains, scattered around the city. The most famous one is the Venetian-style Morozini fountain (aka the Lions fountain, 1628), a landmark for locals and visitors alike. Other noteworthy Venetian fountains are the Bembo fountain (1552-1554) on Kornaros Square, the Sagredo fountain (1602-1604) built in the northwestern corner of the Loggia building, and the Priuli fountain (1666) located near the port. The most interesting Turkish fountains are: Philanthropic fountain (1776), on Kornarou Square next to Bembo fountain, wherein our days you can enjoy a refreshment as it runs as a coffeehouse; Idomeneas fountain (behind the Historical Museum of Crete), Genitsar Aga Fountain (on Ikarou street) and many more.

Among the churches of Heraklion, the one that stands out is the imposing Metropolis of Agios Minas, on Agia Ekaterini Square, built between 1862-1895. Adjacent to it, stands the chapel of Mikros Agios Minas and on the northeast, you can pay a visit to the 16th c. church of Agia Ekaterini, which runs as a museum housing exhibits from the Cretan Renaissance. The church of Agios Markos (13th century) towers over Venizelou Square. Other significant churches in the city are Panagia Akrotiriani, Panagia ton Stavroforon, the Monastery of Agios Petros and Pavlos etc.

The Heraklion Archaeological Museum, one of the most significant museums in Greece, must be added to your to see list; it showcases unique treasures of the Minoan civilization unearthed from Knossos, Phaistos, Malia, and other sites. Other museums that are noteworthy are the Historical Museum, the Museum of Natural History, and the Cretaquarium (aquarium in the area of Gournes). At a short distance from the city of Heraklion, in the area of Hersonissos, you can enjoy a golf game on a court ideal for either beginners or

advanced players.

Last but not least, the food market of Heraklion, is where you will find all sorts of products as well as traditional Cretan ones such the famous Cretan olive oil, raki, local wine, honey, herbs, etc. which you can just as well take back home with you as a souvenir!

Chania

4 nights



A charming 14th-century harbor and lighthouse, a Venetian old town, and Ottoman and Egyptian influences make **Chania** one of the most scenic spots on **Crete**. A walking tour of the old town will introduce you to the Minoan city of **Kydonia**, the Venetian walls, and the bustling **Municipal Market**. If you want to get out into nature, day trip out to the famous **Elafonisi** beach or **Gramvousa** and **Balos** beaches, or trek the **Samaria Gorge** all the way out to sea and the sleepy coastal village of **Agia Roumeli** that's only accessible through the Gorge or by boat.

Delve deeper into Cretan history and culture on kimkim experiences that explore the beautiful surrounding countryside. Take a tour of nearby villages with stops at producers of highly-regarded local food and drink, or a farm-to-table lunch and cooking class at the **Botanical Park & Gardens of Crete**, where three climate zones coexist on the slopes of the plateau of **Omalos**. Or tailor your tour to one of the specialty local products: an olive tour through **Kolymvari** will take you through ancient groves and out to the **Olive Tree Museum of Vouves**, where you'll learn about the many applications of the olive, one of the most celebrated Greek exports, including a soapmaking demonstration.

- Stroll the seafront promenade away from the crowds and out to the neighborhoods of **Halepa**, full of beautiful neoclassical mansions, and **Tabakaria**, the old tannery district is now dotted with small, atmospheric tavernas.
- Enjoy the area's beautiful beaches. **Balos** and **Gramvousa** (accessible only by boat) are some of the best in the world, or stay closer to town and hang out at the sandy, shallow **Kiani** and **Almyrida** beaches.
- Day trip out to **Kournas Lake**, Crete's only freshwater lake and a protected ecosystem full of bird life. Horseback ride, try out a water-cycle ride, or just enjoy the views.
- Get up early to walk through the old port and enjoy the colorful architecture without the crowds.
- Browse the craft shops within Chania or venture out to the arts and crafts village of Verekynthos to find signature Cretan products like "versed" knives with inscribed poems, leather boots, musical instruments and much more.

Heraklion

3 nights



Crete's capital is a city of colossal historical significance, as attested to by the hugely impressive **archaeological museum** that is second-richest in all Greece, and city landmarks like the **Agios Titos Church**, an originally Byzantine place of worship made a Catholic church in the city's Venetian period and a mosque during the Ottoman period, and Orthodox since the 1920s. Centuries of history blend with modern life in the city center and along the vibrant and recently reconstructed seafront.

The **Minoan Palace of Knossos**, one of Europe's most ancient cities and the home of the mythical minotaur, is the star attraction close to the city, along with the **Diktaean Cave**, also known as the **Cave of Zeus** due to its history as one of the possible birth sites of the deity, when Rhea hid from the titan Kronos.

Journey further into the island on kimkim experiences like a countryside tour with a visit to an olive farm, a traditional Greek meal and wine tasting in the village of **Archanes**, or day trip to the uninhabited island of **Chryssi**, south of lerapetra, where golden sand beaches without the crowds await.

- Visit the **Archaeological Museum of Heraklion**, one of the finest of its kind in Greece, with an impressive collection of artifacts second only to the National Museum's.
- If you're in a more earth-centric mood, visit the **Natural History Museum** to learn about the eastern Mediterranean environment, with its exhibits especially suited to kids.
- Stroll from the old town to the lively seafront, stopping in some of stylish cafes for refreshments and seeing one of the city's spectacular fountains like **Morosini Lion's Fountain**, along the way.
- Walk for over 1.25 miles (2 km) along the Venetian Harbor, passing the 16th-century Koules Fortress on the way out to Heraklion lighthouse, getting great views of the nearby coast

Santorini

3 nights



You may feel like you've already seen **Santorini** and its postcard-perfect white cliffside houses, but "wish you were here" pales in comparison to visiting in person, even with the crowds that regularly flood off the ferries and cruise ships. The island got its distinctive crescent shape due to a volcanic eruption thousands of years ago that spread ash as far afield as Egypt and is partially responsible for inspiring legends of Atlantis, the legendary lost continent. Today, you can **hike along the caldera rim**, crossing through all five towns and getting some of the best views along the way, or see the caldera coastline by hopping aboard a **catamaran cruise** that will take you down around the caldera and its volcanic hot springs. Relax on some truly remarkable beaches, many of which get vivid red or black colors from the island's volcanic activity, or taste the island's flavors through vintages like fruity white *Assyrtiko* and sweet red *Vinsanto*. Whatever you decide to do, cap it all watching one or 101 of the island's famously fabulous sunsets, so stunning you can never tire of them.

Get an insider's perspective with kimkim experiences like a guided visit to **Akrotiri**, the prehistoric city that was buried under volcanic ash for 3,000 years, or a tour of an **anhydrous farm** to learn how residents grow Santorini's famous little tomatoes, fava beans, and other specialties—without using water! Then, follow a guide on a tour from the island's pretty sunset-watching hotspot at **Oia** all the way to Santorini's lesser-known medieval settlements such as **Pyrgos**.

- Lounge on the island's volcanic beaches that come in black, red, or white sand to suit any preference.
- Visit the archaeological site of ancient **Thera**, perched cliffside to protect its inhabitants from pirate invasions.
- Have an early dinner at a fish tavern in the small port of **Ammoudi**. The red rocks along the coast here are shown off at their fiery best at sunset.
- Dodge the crowds at the beautiful caldera rim village of Oia by visiting early in the morning or later into the
 evening once the sunset-spotters have receded.
- View sunset from the one of many vantage points along the caldera: **Akrotiri Lighthouse** is a good spot to avoid the crowds at Oia but just what place has the best angle changes every month.



Known for its jetsetting reputation and signature windmills, **Mykonos**, with its nightclubs and the fetching blue-and-white buildings of the **Little Venice** neighborhood, is among the most famous of the Greek islands, and has the crowds to match. This Cycladic island is a cosmopolitan spot, with plentiful clubs, restaurants, and designer shops. Visitors can tour either the hotspots of the main town or head inland to see what Mykonos was like before modern tourism. Another fascinating nearby escape is to the ancient island of **Delos** awaits, the birthplace of twin deities Apollo and Artemis in Greek mythology and a seriously impressive archaeological site.

Kimkim travelers can sail to the uninhabited island of **Rhenia** to swim in the clear waters without the crowds. Alternatively, an inland hike will take you to hidden corners of Mykonos such as lonely **Armenistis Lighthouse**, as will a visit to an off-the-beaten-track organic farm with delicious wines and local products to sample.

- Reserve a seat at one of the island's buzzy beach clubs and spend the day on your sunbed.
- Seek out a quieter beach like the gorgeous **Kalo Livadi**, set on the east side of Mykonos. Though pebbly, it's much quieter than the party beaches, and a great choice if you hope to swim, as the water is almost always warm and calm.
- Experience the island culinary scene at one of the many excellent dining establishments, like **Niko's Taverna**.
- Take a late afternoon walk through **Mykonos Town** to catch the golden hour lighting over popular photo spots like the **windmills** and **Little Venice**. Stop in the shops in search of handmade jewelry and artwork.



Feel the echoes of 3,000 years of history as you explore the streets of **Athens** under the gaze of the **Acropolis** and its iconic **Parthenon**. The modern city wraps around the Acropolis hill, along with imprints left by Byzantine, Ottoman, and neoclassical influences. Whether you're touring some of Europe's greatest ancient monuments, walking alongside a guide through the trendy modern streets of **Koukaki**, **Pangrati**, or **Keramikos** and sampling the mosaic of food and drink along the way, or relaxing in the quietude of gorgeous green spaces like the **National Garden**, there's always something to delight you.

Previous kimkim travelers have found their own ways to interpret the city on photo tours with professional photographers. Other tour options are sure to delight the smaller members of your traveling party: a Painting the Parthenon experience with a professional artist, for example, or doing an Olympic Games workout at the **Panathenaic Stadium**, the world's only 100% marble stadium.

Just outside the city, do not miss the coastline of the up-and-coming **Athenian Riviera**, taking a dip in saltwater **Lake Vouliagmeni**, and watching the sunset over the impressive **Temple of Poseidon** on **Cape Sounion** at the tip of the **Attica Peninsula**.

- Visit the Acropolis at sunset to avoid the crowds and take in the views during the golden hour.
- Stroll down from the Acropolis to the **National Observatory** in the early evening, where the telescope is open to the public three times a week.
- Ride the funicular up to the top of **Lycabettus** hill for panoramic views, then take a walk back down through the park to the posh neighborhood of **Kolonaki** for some quality cafe time.
- Attend a concert or play at the **Odeon of Herodes Atticus**, the ancient theater right beneath the Acropolis.
- Wind your way through the flea market of **Monastiraki** and all the artisan shops in the neighborhood of **Psyrri**, where you'll find handmade sandals, jewelry, pottery, and other unique souvenirs.
