Murano is an island made famous by its 700 century-old tradition of blown glass art. You will visit a glass factory to observe a glassblower create a work of art before your very eyes. You will admire the beautiful array of jewelry, sculpture, and tableware, then you will pick out your favorite one to purchase as a souvenir.

- Today you will meet your persona guide to enjoy a charming private boat tour of the islands of the most famous islans of the Venetian lagoon. Murano, Burano and Torcello,, known all over the world for their characteristic landscape, craftsmanship and history. Murano, famous by its 700 century-old tradition of blown glass art. Here you will observe a glassblower create a work of art before your very eyes. You will continue to visit Burano, famous for the lace making and its colorful fishermen's houses. You will then visit Torcello, a true jewel of the Venetian lagoon with the oldest church in the whole area: the Basilica of Santa Maria Assunta with its Byzantine mosaic.
- Today your guide will wait for you at the hotel lobby. Start your private walking tour of the city to discover the Venice of
  the Venetians through its most typical districts: Rialto with its famous bridge and the colourful animated fish and fruit
  market. During this tour you will walk through narrow streets, the guide will purposely avoid the crowds to let you
  discover the real hidden Venice. You will discover different districts of Venice unknown to the tourists. You will stroll
  through the Fondaco dei Tedeschi with the terrace and "Acqua Alta" library. You will see also campo Santo Giovanni
  and Paolo.
- Today, with your personal guide, you will reach a master carpenter at "squero". The squero is a typical Venetian
  shipyard where small boats such as gondolas, pupparini, sandoli, sciopòni and other boats typical of the Venetian
  lagoon tradition are created, built and repaired. During the visit you will be shown the characteristics of these particular

Venetian boats and the processing techniques. Lo *squerarolo* works by hand as in the past, without the support of written projects and customizing each boat tailored to the buyer. Each master has his own secrets.

- Rowing lesson Today you will learn the basic stroke for rowing in the bow. You will attend a demonstration and then you will try it too, with the boat still moored. You will depart, with each rower taking turns and getting acclimated to the stoke as we glide along a wide, quiet canal. You will cross into the expansive, open lagoon, where you will be encouraged to try rowing a poppa steering the boat yourself at the stern, just like a gondolier. Then, you will return back through the evocative side canals back to the drop-off point. You will have you the possibility to experience the rich heritage of this unique rowing style first-hand!
- Today you will enter the heart of the most authentic Venice; one of the last artisan shops, where a master mask maker
  works papier-mâché according to the ancient traditions of masked masters of the 1300s. You will enjoy a carnival mask
  workshop (made of papier-mâché) where you will be able to unleash your creativity and live a unique experience, fully
  immersing yourself in the centuries-old tradition of Venetian artisans, whose works of art are known and appreciated all
  over the world.
- Today you will attend an opera show at Palazzo Barbarigo Minotto . It will be an unique operatic experience in the
  rooms of the 17th century Palazzo Barbarigo Minotto, a beautiful Grand Canal mansion in San Marco. The palace is
  quite spectacular with six state rooms which are enriched in the first half of the 1700s by artists whose importance is
  still recognized today.
- Journey through the life and work of one of the world's great artists and inventors at the **Leonardo da Vinci Museum** in Venice.
- Make your stay in Venice memorable by visiting the **La Fenice Opera House**. enjoy a real Opera in the one of the best theatre in the world. Ask for shows season
- Today you will enjoy a visit at the Peggy Guggenheim Collection on the Grand Canal of Venice. The Peggy Guggenheim Collection is the personal collection of the legendary patron of the arts Peggy Guggenheim., a niece of Solomon R. Guggenheim. It includes major holdings of Cubism, Abstraction, Surrealism, early American Abstract Expressionism, and postwar European and American painting and sculpture. Artists comprise masterpieces by Jean Arp, Umberto Boccioni, Alexander Calder, Marcel Duchamp, Max Ernst, René Magritte, Joan Miró, Pablo Picasso, Jackson Pollock, Germaine Richier, Gino Severini, Clyfford Still, and Emilio Vedova, among others. It is possible to organise also a private visit and a a special ( romantic ) dinner at the museum after the closing time.

# Florence - Guided tour with Accademia and Uffizi Gallery

Discover the the heart of the city. You will stroll through streets, alleys of the medieval quarter to Palazzo del Bargello (exterior visit only) and Piazza della Signoria, where sculptures beckon. Continue to Santa Croce Church (Basilica of the Holy Cross), famed as the "Westminster Abbey of Florence". It is a gorgeous Florence church with frescoes by Giotto, architecture by Brunelleschi and houses the tombs of Michelangelo, Galileo and other Tuscan cultural giants. Next, visit the **Accademia Gallery** with the famous Michelangelo's masterpiece: **The David**. You are able to view the museum's other unique pieces, including a room dedicated to Michelangelo. Continue along the Medici Chapels (exterior view only) and Basilica di S. Lorenzo, church of the once influential Medici Family (exterior view only). Finally arrive at Piazza del **Duomo** and marvel at the vast Cathedral (exterior visit only). You will continue to the visit to **Uffizi Gallery**, one of the most beautiful and famous museums in the world boasting a hall of fame of the most important artists of all times: Leonardo da Vinci, Raphael, Michelangelo, Botticelli, Caravaggio and many others.

# Cinque Terre (Five Lands) - Private guided tour

You will reach a **winery** in **Chianti** area to enjoy a wine tasting. Enjoy a unique and exclusive experience guiding you through the production process from vine to **wine**. The visit begins in front of the vineyards, where you will be welcomed by one of our experts who will introduce you to the **Chianti Classico** area, and the history of the Estate. The experience will continue with the tour of our **wine cellar**, where the vinification and wine ageing processes take place. At the end of the tour, your host will guide you through a private tasting featuring a selection of 5 wines selected, and the Extra-Virgin Olive Oil served with Tuscan bread and artisan cheese.

- You meet up with your "Searching Truffle" an expert Truffle-gatherer of the San Miniato hills, and his inseparable dog, you will lead for a walk in the woods with them. It's the opportunity to discover this "treasure" hidden in the woods of San Miniato and the dog's training methods. After the walk, some experts will explain to you the working processes and uses of truffle, then a wonderful tasting lunch of Truffles in a real truffle factory, where it is possible to understand better why this incredible product of the Earth is called the "White Gold" and taste a wonderfullunch of local food based on truffle ingredients.
- In the early morning you will enjoy a **hot air balloon ride**. You will fly above the beautiful hills of Chianti at the early hours of the morning. Discover the rolling fields of Tuscany from a unique aerial perspective with a luxury hot air balloon ride. After getting picked up from your hotel, head to the starting point where you will receive a quick safety briefing before take-off. If you wish, you can help with the aeration of the balloon before entering the cart for your flight. During your **1-hour flight**, you will sail at heights varying from 500 feet to 3000 feet, depending on the wind of that day.   of Montepulciano. Continue the drive to a vineyard for a wine taste and lunch. In the afternoon stop in another vineyard

- Visit Lucca, which is the only old town in Italy entirely surrounded by walls which are still very well preserved. Visit the
  San Frediano church, with its magnificent thirteenth-century mosaic representing Christ in Majesty. Then, explore the
  Piazza del Anfiteatro, the most beautiful square of Lucca passing by elegant shops of Via Filungo through small
  medieval streets. End in the Duomo which houses the famous Volto Santo and the splendid llaria del Caretto

- sarcophagus, a masterpiece of Jacopo della Quercia. Passing **Piazza Napoleone**, we finally arrive at **Piazza San Michele**, the central civic square of Lucca since Roman times.

  Porta Santa Maria. From here you will see a unique panorama of Piazza dei Miracoli with its marble architecture and
