### **Wednesday, July 5<sup>th</sup> 2023**

*Arrival in Venice airport private transfer to hotel evening gondola ride*

Taking a gondola ride in Venice gives you a completely different perspective of the city than exploring it on foot. They have been a tradition in Venice for centuries. Initially used to transport goods down the narrow canals of Venice, today gondolas are primarily used for sightseeing and ceremonial functions*

**Thursday, July 6<sup>th</sup> 2023**

*Private boat tour to Murano Island (4 hours)*

**Murano Island: The Wonders of Murano Glass**

*It is not exactly known when glass making began, however it was confined to Murano by a law passed in 1291. Since then, Murano glass has been known all over the world for its craftsmanship, imagination, creativity and originality. Just as it has been done for centuries, Murano glass is still made by hand with a team of artisans known as a “piazza” who work around the glass master seated in his “scagno” as he directs and works the glass with his team. Your guide will pick you up at the hotel with a private boat and will take you to Murano to see how this famous glass is made. Your assistant will lead you behind the doors of the various glass masters’ studios where you will have the opportunity to see how the different techniques are used to make sculptures, drinking glasses and chandeliers. Then you will visit a factory showroom where you can order and purchase customized pieces at whole sale prices, all with the guarantee that you are buying **hand-made Murano glass**.*

### **Friday, July 7<sup>th</sup> 2023**

### **St Mark's Square**

*The guide will meet you for the walking tour that explains the historical background of Venice. While visiting St. Mark's square, with the **Golden Basilica** (inside) and the **Doge's palace** (inside), you will see some of the most admired and well-known monuments and architectural jewels. The Doge's Palace is a masterpiece of Gothic architecture with vast council chambers and delicately decorated residential apartments. The interior is filled with works by artists such as Titian, Veronese, Tintoretto, Vittoria and Tiepolo. Finally, you will have a short walk to the **Bridge of Sighs** that connects Palazzo Ducale to the 16th-century Prigione Nove (New Prisons). Its improbable popularity is due to British libertine Lord Byron (1788–1824), who mentioned it in one of his long narrative poems Childe Harold's Pilgrimage. Condemned prisoners were said to sigh as they passed through the enclosed bridge and glimpsed the beauty of the lagoon. Now the sighs are mainly from people trying to dodge*

*the picture-snapping masses!*

*In the early afternoon Take a private transfer to the Venice train station to catch a high speed train to Milan here meet your personal assistance and together with your driver reach your hotel.*

## Milan highlights

*After breakfast, meet your private English-speaking guide at the lobby of your hotel for a 3-hour sightseeing tour of Milan.*

*Rome might be the political capital of Italy, but when it comes to fashion and business, Milan undoubtedly wears the crown; indeed it might be said to have more in common with New York than Naples. That said, it is still undoubtedly Italian, just with a little more pace than other cities. When it comes to history, however, there's plenty to see and this tour starts in the **Piazza Duomo**, with its iconic cathedral, the fourth largest in the world. Like most great cathedrals, it was centuries in the building and has many different styles, but the overwhelming impression is gothic magnificence. Just across from the cathedral is the spectacular **Galleria Vittorio Emanuele**, an elegant 19th-century shopping center and one of the first of its kind. Built in 1865, just after Italian unification, a central mosaic celebrates all the major cities of the newly unified Italy. The designer shops here give you a foretaste for the other principal shopping streets, the Via Montenapoleone and the Via Della Spiga. Your guide will then take you to **Piazza della Scala**, where you will see Milan's world-famous opera house, **La Scala Theatre**.*

### **Sunday, July 9<sup>th</sup> 2023**

*Group Boat tour to Capri Island (7 hours – max 12 participants)*



- Reach the selected meeting point on your own and join a transfer to Sorrento Port
- **Inclusions:** pick-up to/from the port, Professional skipper English-speaking, snacks, Alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, Equipment for snorkeling

- Landing tax in Capri € 2,50 per person to be paid directly on site.

### **Capri by boat**

*Pick-up from a designated meeting point and transfer to the port of Piano di Sorrento.*

*Departure to Capri, sailing along the Sorrento Coast. Along the way you will admire: the ancient fishermen village of "Marina Grande", the ruins of a roman villa near "Bagni della Regina Giovanna",*

*the natural waterfall that flows from the rock, and other interesting attractions along the coast. Arrival to Capri and tour of the island by boat with stops to visit the Marvelous Grotto, the White Grotto, the Green Grotto; along the way you will admire the Natural Arch, the Villa Curzio Malaparte, the Faraglioni rocks and the Lighthouse of Punta Carena.*

*There will be a one stop for swimming and snorkeling, and a relaxing break with snacks and drinks offered on board.*

*Stop from 3 to 5 hours to visit the island by land.*

*Departure from Capri to Sorrento with limoncello tasting.*

*Return to the port of Piano di Sorrento and transfer to the meeting point.*

*\*The stop the Blue Grotto is not included in the itinerary of this tour due the long waiting time. All the guests interested to visit the Blue grotto can do it during the free time on the island.*

*Private guided tour of Amalfi Coast Villages: Amalfi, Positano with wine tasting and lunch at tenuta di San Francesco (8 hours)*

### **Amalfi Coast villages: Amalfi, Positano**

*Today enjoy a drive along the stunning **Amalfi Coast** with your private car and driver guide for a full day tour.*

*Dramatic, deluxe and more than a little dashing, **Positano** is the Amalfi Coast's front-cover splash, with vertiginous houses tumbling down to the sea in a cascade of sun-bleached peach, pink and terracotta. No less photo-worthy are its steep streets and steps, flanked by wisteria-draped hotels, smart restaurants and fashionable retailers.*

*Stop in Piazza dei Mulini (the most famous square in Positano), and walk through the narrow streets leading to the waterfront. These streets also lead to the cathedral and are characterized by shops selling lemons, shoes and clothing.*

*Enjoy a **wine tasting at the Tenuta di San Francesco In Tramonti**, in the heart of the Amalfi Coast, which produces rare, unique and authentic wines, from ancient and pre-phylloxera vines. (Wine tasting and light lunch included).*

*Tramonti, green and fertile valley of the Amalfi Coast, recognized as a Unesco World Heritage Site, is rich of terraces stolen from the mountains, planted with vineyards, lemon and olive groves. The steep slopes, sunny weather, warm breeze that blows from the Gulf of Salerno make the region perfect for growing wine grapes.*

*Tour the vineyard, one of Italy's most renowned, and learn about the traditional techniques and dedication to excellence which has earned Marisa Cuomo Winery both national and international recognition. En joy a superb lunch paired wiht local wines.*

*It is hard to grasp that pretty little **Amalfi**, with its sun-filled piazzas and small beach, was once a maritime superpower. For one thing, it's not a big place – you can easily walk from one end to the*

other in about 20 minutes. For another, there are very few historical buildings of note. The explanation is chilling: most of the old city, and its inhabitants, simply slid into the sea during an earthquake in 1343.

### **Thursday, July 10<sup>rd</sup> 2023**

*Concierge Rail Naples/Rome stop en route in Pompeii*

After a relaxing breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to Sorrento. Catch a high-speed train back to Rome, then check in to your hotel.

According to legend, Rome was founded by brothers Romulus and Remus in 753 B.C.E. atop Rome's Palatine Hill. The long-time center of the powerful Roman Empire, Rome boasts nearly 3,000 years of architecture, history, and culture. These days, Italy's capital is considered one of Europe's top

cities thanks to its ancient monuments, incredible art masterpieces, and cosmopolitan vibe. It's a center for fashion with buzzing food culture and has a growing nightlife scene.

Stop en route on a 2 hour guided tour to visit Pompeii which is probably as close as we can get to travel in a time machine, to ancient Rome. In August, 79 AD, Vesuvius had been rumbling for some days and it is estimated that a large part of the population of 20,000 had been evacuated; those that were left were as if suspended in time, as the plaster casts made of the bodies that were found shows. Excavation started in the 18th century and continues to this day. The first impression, on entering into the Forum, is just how massive Roman structures were; they really dwarf revered Medieval or later sites. You will get to walk Roman streets, look into bars, stroll into Patrician villas, complete with frescoes and mosaics, there is even a mosaic doormat, saying 'beware of the dog'. Even graffiti (an Italian word) is written on some of the walls, reflecting a forthcoming election. When you see the baths, the central heating systems, and the gentle fountains in the courtyards of the villas, you really feel it wouldn't be too much of a hardship to live there.

upon arrival at the Rome train station, you will be privately transferred to your hotel where you will check-in and relax.
