# DETAILED ITINERARY



## **Day 1 - Thursday 28 Sep 2023: Hanoi Arrival (Flight details to be advised – Own tickets)/ International Airport Arrival Assistance Service/ Private Airport Transfer with English Speaking Guide “ESG”**

As soon as you deplane, our Airport Assistance Staff will meet you just before the entrance to Immigration (or at the entrance of the terminal if there's no jet bridge), holding a signboard with your name(s) on it. The officer will assist and take you to the priority line for immigration procedures and provide support at the visa counter. For those who already have their Vietnam visa, the estimated time to clear immigration is approximately 15-20mins per person. For those applying for a visa on arrival, the estimated wait time for the visa is usually 30 mins, depending on the number of guests in the queue. (FYI, there is only one visa-on-arrival counter at Noi Bai Airport). After clearing immigration, our Immigration Officer will escort you to baggage reclaim to collect your luggage and introduce you to your guide, who will be waiting outside the terminal.

- Porter or luggage assistance is at an extra cost

Upon arrival at Noi Bai Airport, either Domestic or International arrival, after clearing all customs procedures, please proceed to exit gate and look for your guide who will be waiting at the lobby, holding the Trails of Indochina signboard with your name on it, if you cannot locate your guide, please go to the Airport Information counter situated in the middle of Domestic and International arrival lobby (inside the terminal) and call the emergency numbers (+84) 9 1323 7040 for assistance. Your guide will come to meet you up and transfer you to hotel.

## **Day 2 - Friday 29 Sep 2023: Morning Leisure/ Afternoon Street Food Tour**

Enjoy your morning at leisure after a long flight (No car and no guide at disposal).

Eating on the street is a very typical activity for Hanoians and makes up an important part of the city's unique culture. Depart at **15:30** for a leisurely walk with our tour guide to **the Old Quarter**. Make your way through streets lined with food vendors tending steaming vats of **Pho Ga (Vietnamese noodle soup with chicken)** and line up with the other hungry customers to try this tasty cuisine. Pho Ga is practically Vietnam's national dish, consumed almost religiously throughout the day. After experiencing Hanoi's insatiable demand for Pho, head to a nearby street market, alive with the sights and sounds of Hanoi - it is the essence of Vietnamese street culture. Sit down at a tiny shop to try a bit of **Banh Duc** - cooked rice powder with Vietnamese spices, served cool or hot depending on weather. Your next stop is another little shop selling many different types of traditional Northern cakes, such as **Com cake (young rice)**, considered to be a part of every Hanoians' childhood. Follow your guide into a small alley to get an idea of a typical "tube house" in Hanoi and then stop for a tasty **banh mi at Banh My Lan Ong** and try their famous bread with **Pâté**. Your savory appetite sated, enjoy some **che** - a Vietnamese sweet soup. Cap off your trip by tasting a cup of Vietnamese egg coffee before returning back to your hotel.

## Day 3 - Saturday 30 Sep 2023: A Day In The Life Of A Hanoian & City Highlights With Old Quarter Cyclo

Today's tour guide will take you to the "**standing newspaper**" where your guide will tell a fascinating story of a time when newspapers were considered a luxury in Hanoi. Next, stop at a **local coffee shop to observe the rush of daily life in the Old Quarter**, before transferring to **Gioi Market – the corner where thousands of trade goods are sold**. From kitchenware to motorcycle parts, this market has everything! Continue your exploration by driving to the rail station in a **Hanoi suburb and catch a local train back to the city centre**. After a 10-minute train ride that passes over the first French bridge built on the Red River, finish the tour by having lunch at a vintage Vietnamese restaurant decked out in 70's décor that will take you back in time to a recently liberated Hanoi.

Explore the charming city of Hanoi, often referred to as the 'Paris of the East', with its yellow ochre colonial buildings, tree-lined boulevards and scenic lakes. Visit to the **Temple of Literature**, Vietnam's first national university built in the late 11<sup>th</sup> century. The picturesque temple is an example of well-preserved traditional Vietnamese architecture and is featured on the back of the 100,000 Vietnamese dong banknote. Continue to the **Vietnamese Women's Museum**, offering broad insights into the people of Vietnam, including its 54 ethnic groups, through the lens of women's topics. Walk through diverse exhibitions showcasing everything from street vendors and marriage to family life and traditional fashion.

Drive back to central Hanoi for a cyclo tour through the photogenic **Old Quarter** where each street is named after the goods originally sold there, from silk to silver. Explore the fascinating maze of back streets, fronted by narrow houses known as "tunnel" or "tube houses", built to avoid taxes based on the width of their frontage onto the street, a wonderfully eclectic glimpse into Hanoi street life.

#### **Day 4 - Sunday 01 Oct 2023: Hanoi - Hai Phong - Cat Ba**

Depart Hanoi and drive 2.5hrs to **Hai Phong**, the gateway to Halong Bay. Travel like a local and embark on a 45min hydrofoil to **Cat Ba Island**. A 30min land transfer takes you to **Cat Ba National Park**. Commence trekking through the park which possesses a unique variety of flora and fauna. Trek 6km (4mi) to **Frog Lake** to admire the magical landscape of submerged trees. Enjoy a picnic lunch in this serene setting. Continue trekking for another 3km (2mi) to the scenic **Viet Hai Village** where you can see rice fields, fruit plantations and experience local life. (Please wear appropriate footwear as this section of the trek is slippery due to walking on limestone.) Afterwards, walk around the village for an up-close view. Board a wooden motorboat at Viet Hai Pier for a 1hr cruise to the Beo Pier where you will transfer to your resort for dinner and overnight.

#### **Day 5 - Monday 02 Oct 2023: Cat Ba - Halong Bay**

Around 09:30, check out of the resort and drive 35mins to Gia Luan Pier where you will board a day boat and cruise approximately 1hr to the Halong Pier.

12.15PM Boarding our boat at Tuan Chau Port – enjoy welcome drink, receive cruise briefing and safety instructions. Enjoy the deluxe Vietnamese Set Menu Lunch. Cruise through Halong Bay, passing the most beautiful and quiet areas including Incense Burner, Dog Stone Islet, Fighting Cock, Finger Islet. Arrive at Surprise Cave - one of the most spectacular and largest grottoes of Halong Bay. The mouth of the grotto is reached by ascending about a hundred stone steps. Depart and sail for about 30 minutes to anchor overnight. Attend the Fruit and Vegetable Carving Lesson led by our Head Chef. During the lesson, the chef will conduct Fruit and Vegetable carving, showing the guests how we decorate and make some traditional Vietnamese Dinner is served and evening activities. Board games like cards or Parcheesi are available. Also, everyone can try their luck at squid fishing on the boat with help from the crew. Happy Hour! Buy one drink – get one free (wine by the bottle excluded).

**Day 6 - Tuesday 03 Oct 2023: Ha Long Bay**

Coffee, tea and breakfast pastries served in the dining room. Enjoy Tai Chi lesson on the sundeck (lasting for about 30 minutes). Enjoy Breakfast served in the dining room.

Guests are transferred to the Indochina Sails Day Boat, a spacious and comfortable wooden junk with lounge, dining room and sundeck. Daytime activities include cruising to less trafficked areas of the Bay, visiting Luon Cave – guests can find golden hair monkeys here. Explore Cua Van Floating Village. This is one of the largest fishing villages on the Bay. Guests can choose between kayaking through the village or visiting on small bamboo boats (sampan) rowed by villagers. Kayakers will depart from the boat in two-seater, self-rowed kayaks, kayaking through the village and back to the boat. A kayaking tour guide will lead the way. Lunch is served on board mid-day. After lunch, guests will pay a visit to Pearl Farm. Return by tender to the Indochina Sails boat. Rejoin the cruise and relax onboard as we sail to the overnight anchorage. Dinner is served. Also, everyone can try luck at squid fishing on the boat with help from the crew. Happy Hour! Buy one drink – get one free (wine by the bottle excluded).

After the climb, there is time left to relax on the beach and have a swim.

9:00AM: Upon returning to the boat, guests will have 30 minutes to freshen up and finish packing. Please collect all of your belongings from the cabins and leave heavy luggage outside the cabins (staff will transfer directly to the pier).

9:30AM: Enjoy a full breakfast in the dining room. Bills are settled after breakfast. Relax on the sundeck or in the dining room enjoying the bay scenery as we approach the pier.

11:00AM Arrive at Tuan Chau port, relax inside the pier building while waiting for return transportation.

Your guide will meet you at the pier and transfer you back to Hanoi.

After check out hotel, your guide will transfer you from your accommodation to the airport for your flight to Danang.

Upon arrival at Danang Airport, after collecting your luggage, please proceed to exit gate and look for your guide who will be waiting at the lobby, holding the Trails of Indochina signboard with your name on it, if you cannot locate your guide, please go to the nearest Information counter and have them call the emergency number (+84) 9 1349 3398 for assistance. Your guide will come to meet you up and transfer you to hotel in Hoi An.

Hoi An by night is always busy with hundreds of food stalls and local restaurants. This evening, take a walk around the town at night and you discover many vendors offering Hoi An specialties. This tour takes you off the beaten path to get a unique glimpse into nightly life of this lovely ancient town and discover unforgettable street food. Meet your tour guide and start zigzagging through the alleys to explore a popular snack – “white rose”. It is a Find your way to a “banh mi” stand owned by an elderly woman and try a small piece of crispy baguette sa crispy Fried Wonton “Hoanh Thanh Chien”. Next stroll to a hidden family restaurant serving barbecued pork which you combine with fresh greens and herbs to create your own fresh spring roll. It is the best to enjoy the roll with cold beer! Walk further into the central of the village for a look at the ancient sweet soup “Che” before capping off the journey at the riverside to release floating lanterns for good luck.

After check out hotel, your guide will transfer you from your Hoi An hotel to Danang airport for your flight to Saigon.

Upon arrival **Tan Son Nhat airport**, after collecting your luggage, please proceed to exit gate and look for your guide who will be waiting at the lobby, holding the Trails of Indochina signboard with your name on it. If you cannot locate your guide, please come to the closest Information booth and have them call the emergency number **(+84) 9 1871 3456**. Your guide will come to meet you and transfer you to hotel.

The darker the night gets, the more vivid Saigon becomes! Get ready for a fascinating ride by vintage Vespa tonight to discover the busy Saigon after dark, together with beautiful street foods tasting in the most authentic local restaurants. Make your first stop at a small yet popular Vietnamese bread stall, line up to get fresh bread roll before heading to a local coffee shop for briefing. Keep on riding to a hidden boutique seafood restaurant to taste the freshest local seafood courses. Then continue to zig zag through the hustle bustle streets, wander around an old apartment complex which becomes extremely lively at night with hundreds of food and drinks stalls. Take a break at a 50-year-old desserts shop to try different hand-made sweet soups. End up your night at a cozy bar room tucked away in a quiet alley to taste some local beer and have a chat with people here. Take a walk or catch a taxi to get back

If you have never visited Saigon - the city on the move, then it is a good idea to discover this city by motorcycles. Get well prepared that the traffic moves in a different way that at home. The roads are always busy with motorbikes, cars and buses. But take it easy, Saigonese knows how to handle all the turns. You will sit behind experienced drivers who understand their vespa and the traffic like the back of their hands. Only by sitting on a motorcycle that you can zig zag through the narrow alleys, bustling residential area to capture the real night life of Saigonese.

**Day 12 - Monday 09 Oct 2023: Hidden Secrets Of Saigon**

Behind its glitzy, newly-built skyscrapers and modern pace of life, Saigon shelters a plethora of little known stories about its fascinating history and culture hidden away from the main districts of the city. Visit a **secret weapons chamber** which the Viet Cong used as a place to hide and store weapons during the Vietnam War. Weave through back alleys and meet some of the locals who live in narrow small houses in space-starved Saigon. Then chill out at a **coffee shop tucked away in an old French colonial-era apartment block**. Meander across a local market to meet a street artist who has spent half of his life **making souvenir carvings**. Finally, visit a hidden restaurant accessed through an antique elevator before returning to your hotel.

Depart Saigon for a 1.5hr drive to Ben Tre, the gateway to the Mekong Delta. Escape the high-energy city for a day of exploring sprawling rice paddies and colorful fruit farms. Arrive at the quaint An Khanh hamlet, where travelers will visit a small home factory that makes the traditional dish of sticky rice covered by coconut leaves. Meet with the owner and her hard-working team who will teach you about how they use century-old traditional methods to make this special and tasty cake. Continue this rural journey of discovery with a short drive to meet a local family in Quoi Son village, where you can sample exotic fresh fruits in the orchard of a local fruit farmer. After wandering through the lush gardens of this village, a motorboat awaits your arrival to begin a thirty-minute excursion passing peaceful scenes of countryside living. Trade boat for bicycle and enjoy a relaxing ride over easy, level terrain as you travel through narrow village lanes lined with fruit orchards and customary cottages. Here you will take auto rickshaw through the lush surroundings of the fruit farms before boarding a sampan and cruise along the narrow canals of the Mekong. End your excursion at a local farmer's house where a lunch of Mekong Delta specialties will be served before driving back to Saigon.

### **VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ARRIVAL BY AIR**

Please ensure your passport is valid more than 6 months from the date of return for every country you are visiting. Please also ensure there is sufficient space in your passport to allow for all immigration procedures, taking note that some South East Asian countries take up a full page for the visa sticker and need yet more space on a separate page for entry & exist stamps.

Kindly note that visa service is not included in our proposal. Please contact Trails of Indochina for any visa service or guidance. Please note the following general information is subject to change concerning visas from our part of the world.

**Vietnam:** Visa on arrival has been suspended (until further notice). You must apply e-visa via:

It is recommended to apply e-visa 7 to 14 days before departure.

## **TRIP AND TRAVEL INSURANCE**
