These days, you have a lot of options to choose from for you to enjoy the entirety of Boracay Island.


Here are some of our recommendations:

- For packages with flights, the port tax at airports for domestic flights (200 pesos per person for about \$4)
- In case one of your crossings is done by ferry, you should know that we cannot pay for the luggage in advance and you will have to pay for it on the spot as well as pay port taxes (large suitcase 100 pesos, small suitcase 50 pesos and port taxes 50 pesos per person)
- If it is necessary to change the hotel (REBOOKING) or alternatively a hotel has been canceled and a new hotel must be booked with an additional fee due to factors related to the hotel the customer will bear this expense.

#### **Cancellation Policy:**

- 1. All services are allowed to be rebooked to a different date and price however fare difference may apply, if given at least 1 week advance notice.
- 2. Flights' and accommodations' rates can cause price difference due to seasonality and availability in case of rebooking.
- 3. No refund will be given under any circumstance and clients are required to avail of a travel insurance that covers COVID-19 causes with at least \$35,000 coverage.

#### **General Information:**

- The local currency is a Philippine Peso and is marked with PHP.
- Dollars and euros can be exchanged to Philippine Peso at the airport in Manila.
- There are ATMs in Manila, Cebu, Boracay and Bohol that accepts most credit cards (except American Express and Diners).
- In general the minimum baggage weight is 20 kg in domestic flights for check-in and 7 kg for hand carry items, and a passenger who exceeds the limit of either will have to pay for the extra weight.
- It is important to note that lunches on day trips are simple local Filipino meal that includes rice, fish, chicken and vegetables.
- In order to enter the Philippines, a valid passport is required for at least six months before expiration date.
- All vacationers should have a round trip tickets to and from the Philippines.
