### DAY 1 Flight into Victoria Falls

Connecting flight to Victoria Falls Airport. The Ilala Lodge is located on the edge of the Victoria Falls National Park, the view from the rooms look across the lawns into the Park where elephant, warthog, impala or the occasional buffalo might be seen. 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### DAY 2 Visit to Victoria Falls

Your stay includes breakfast and a walking tour of Victoria Falls. One of the original natural wonders of the world, the Victoria Falls is now also a World Heritage Site. Known locally as 'The Smoke that Thunders' this spectacle is accessible from both Zambia and Zimbabwe. Unlike other waterfalls Victoria Falls has a natural catwalk across from the falls which provides for spectacular viewing. To get a birds-eye-view of the Falls it is possible to take a helicopter flip or a flight on a microlight. Looking for adventure? Acclaimed as the "wildest one-day whitewater run in the World" and recognised by rafting enthusiasts as one of the top ten paddling rivers on the planet! It is also possible to do a gentle paddle in a canoe on the upper Zambezi. [Read less](#)

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### DAY 3 Chobe National Park Botswana

1.5 Hour road transfer to Kasane. 1 Hour road transfer to Chobe National Park. The Owner run and managed the Muchenje Safari Lodge is situated on the western edge of Chobe National park. Muchenje offers unique, prolific game experiences within this quieter region of the Park. Safaris are conducted both by boat and on land. Witness massive herds of elephant coming down to the river to drink as the sun sets over the Chobe River. [Read less](#)

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### DAY 4 Chobe National Park Botswana

Chobe National Park is well known for it's large herds of elephant that frequent the Chobe River on a daily basis. In the dry season an estimate of up to 85000 elephants can be dispersed within Park, where the majority of them can be found along the river. Apart from the herds of elephants, the park has lion, leopard, buffalo and a whole host of antelope like sable, puku, kudu, eland, roan and many others which guests can also get to see. The river is filled with big pods of hippos and some of the biggest crocodiles in Africa. Take advantage of the safari options available. Game viewing by boat on the Chobe River offers close-up wildlife encounters. [Read less](#)
