ITINERARY**Day 1** Punta Arenas – Puerto Natales (250 km)

Arrive (usually after midday) and transfer by bus to the beautiful fisherman village of Puerto Natales to check-in to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure to explore Puerto Natales.

Puerto Natales is not only the gateway to Torres del Paine national but has also become a popular tourist destination itself. Cafes, restaurants, shops and pubs now line the streets giving tourists the opportunity to enrich themselves into the Chilean culture. As well as food options Puerto Natales also offers visitors an abundance of outdoor activities.

Departure from your Hotel to begin a full day excursion to the Torres del Paine National Park. We'll visit the main highlights; Towers of Paine,

the horns, Salto Grande Waterfall, Nordenskjold, and Lake Pehoe. Throughout the National Park, you will be able to view Guanacos and Foxes, as well as a variety of birds. After the tour you will be transferred to your hotel in Puerto Natales. (BL)

Day 3 Puerto Natales

Today is a free day to explore Puerto Natales. We recommend booking an additional sightseeing for today locally as most activities are weather permitting. Our recommendation is to head back to Torre Del Paine National Park and visit Grey Glacier or trek to the base of the towers. (B)

Day 4 Puerto Natales - Punta Arenas (250 km)

After an early morning breakfast, depart for Punta Arenas Airport. The package ends with your arrival at the airport in the late afternoon. (B)

Day 1 Arrive Buenos Aires

Buenos Aires, a sophisticated city with a strong European influence and culture. With its blend of Spanish, French and Italian architectural styles, great variety of night spots and cultural life it is often referred to as the “South American Paris”. Although Buenos Aires is a very large city it is easy to explore on foot. Upon arrival of your flight be transferred to your hotel located for the 3 nights. The rest of the afternoon is free to explore. Tonight, we recommend you head to one of Argentina’s Parrillas and dine on a delicious Argentine steak.

Day 2 Buenos Aires

Today enjoy a half day city of Buenos Aires. Start off by visiting Plaza de Mayo, the historical, political and cultural centre of the city. Then head to the colourful district of La Boca, drive past the national Congress, 9 de Julio Avenue, Palermo and The Cemetery of Recoleta. The rest of the afternoon at leisure. Tonight, you are in for a real treat! Depart from the hotel and head to the South Zone of the city where majority of the traditional tangueras are located. Enjoy dinner and a show with a night of music with typical songs and dances will be performed. Drop off at hotel around midnight. (B,D)

Day 3 Buenos Aires

Day at leisure. We recommend book an optional tour to Tigre and the River Delta. Not far from Buenos Aires an entirely different landscape awaits. Enjoy a boat ride through Tigre on the river Delta, learn about the culture of the natives and enjoy a glimpse of how the locals live along the peaceful canals. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant on the river and relax in nature before being taken back to your hotel. (B)

Day 4 Buenos Aires - Iguazu

Today after breakfast you will be transferred to the airport for your domestic flight to Iguazu (flights not included- please ask our staff for a price). One of the planet’s most amazing sights, Iguazu falls are simply jaw dropping. Covered in natural lush rainforest beaming with unique flora and fauna there are so many amazing sights. The falls stretch nearly 3 km across Argentina and Brazil, has over 275 individual waterfalls and on average 1,500 cubic metre of water flows every second. It is no understatement to call Iguazu falls one of the New 7 Wonders of the Natural World.

Upon arrival into Iguazu be met by our local representative who will transfer you to your hotel for the next 2 nights. (B)

Day 5 Iguazu Falls

This morning, enjoy a full day guided coach tour of the Argentinean side of Iguazu Falls. Leave on foot from the hotel and follow a series of pathways that offers so many different views of the cascading falls. Upon arrival at the “Central Station” you’ll have 2 choices, take the train that goes to falls station or the one that goes to Devil’s Throat Station. The “Devil’s Throat” is the largest of all the waterfalls in Iguazu marks the border between Brazil and Argentina. (B)

Day 6 Iguazu Falls - Rio de Janeiro

This morning explores the Brazilian side of the falls. Take the trail that descends into the canyon that offers panoramic views of falls. The trip continues towards the National Park Do Lguacu, one of the biggest vegetation reserves in Brazil. The trails will give you panoramic views of the falls as well as views of Isla San Martin, the Bossetti, San Martin and the three Musketeers and the “Devil’s Throat”. In the afternoon you will be met and transferred to the airport for your departure flight to Rio (flight not included). Rio de Janeiro is such an extraordinary city from the sun-drenched beauty of its white sandy beaches to the generous hospitality of the “Cariocas” (as the town’s natives are called), Rio offers a combination that is hard to match. It is not only a beach resort combining tropical beauty and mountain views, but a sophisticated city as well. Upon arrival into Rio be met by our local representative for a private transfer to your hotel where the rest of day is leisure. (B)

Day 7 Rio de Janeiro

After breakfast depart from the hotel to visit some of the famous landmarks in Rio de Janeiro. After a scenic drive along Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, arrive at the bottom of the Corcovado Hill. Embark on the cable car that ascends into the mountain, where Christ the Redeemer is located. Christ the Redeemer, known as the “wonder of Rio” and is also none as one of the new 7 New Wonders of the World. After lunch you will head towards the other world-famous landmark, Sugar Loaf Mountain. Afterwards we’ll stop by the Municipal Theatre and the Cathedral on our way back to the hotel. The rest of the afternoon is free for you to explore Rio’s famous night life and street markets. (B,L)

Day 8 Rio de Janeiro

Day at leisure. We recommend you head to Copacabana beach to soak up the rays or head to one of the local shopping centres and shop till you drop! (B)

Day 9 Rio de Janeiro

After breakfast, you will be met in the hotel lobby for a private transfer to the airport. (B)
