21 Sep Bergen

This morning after breakfast your guide will come pick you up for the private guided walking tour.

An authorised local guide will join you on a guided tour by foot around the city of Bergen. You will visit the Fish & Flower Market, St Mary's Church, the Hanseatic Museum and the Hanseatic Bryggen Harbour. No entrances have been included on this tour but are available upon request.

Later that day we experience the Fløibanen funicular in Bergen is one of Norway's best-known attractions. Fløibanen can be found in the heart of Bergen, 150 m from Fisketorget - the fish market - and Bryggen wharf, and it takes just 10 minutes to walk to the lower station from where the cruise ships dock along Bryggen. The journey up to Fløyen (320 m above sea level) takes 5-8 minutes and is an experience in itself. At the top, you can enjoy fantastic views over Bergen. There are endless opportunities for walks on Fløyen, and you will also find a cafe, restaurant and children's playground.

The funicular runs daily all year round from early morning to late evening.

23 Sep Ulvik

This morning after a nice breakfast we take a fjord cruise from Flam to Gudvangen.

You will spend a few hours in Gudvangen with an entrance to the Viking Njardarheimr.

Travel thousand years back and experience how it was to be a Viking. In Njardarheimr Viking Valley, you get to explore a real Viking community with real Vikings that lives almost like in the Viking age most of the year.

Walking around the town of Njardarheimr, you will learn about Viking life, routines, architecture, religion, food and handicraft.

Gathering around meals was important also in the Viking age. In "Heidrun", you can taste food made by old methods with ingredients available 1000 years ago. What about a freshly baked pan bread with salmon or cured sausage with wild-garlic sour cream for lunch?

To get most out of your visit, we recommend you to join "The Viking Experience". This is a 45 minutes guided tour of the town, included in the entry ticket.

After the viking experience you have a private transfer from Gudvangen to Ulvik where you are dropped at your hotel.

24 Sep Ulvik

This morning after breakfast we go on a private tour of a cider farm.

Ulvik is probably most famous for its fruit and cider farms.The Hardanger Fjord area is known as the fruit orchard of Norway. Nowhere on the world is it possible to grow fruit on this latitude (about 60 degrees north). The mild climate in the Hardanger region, the protective geography from the elements and the long summer days add up to an ideal location for fruit farming.

We take you along the cider route and stop by these family run cider farms where you can experience the pride and legacy, which the owners have put in their products for generations. Every cider farm has its unique specialty and approach to processing fruit and food. And we might just have a tasting sample on the way.

Details

This activity is a guided walk along the cider route, where you become familiar with the cider farms and their productions.

Difficulty and Safety

This tour is intended for all age groups. No special requirements are expected. Young children from age 5 can participate, if accompanied by parents.
