This morning you'll travel to the Valdes Peninsula, where your first stop will be at the Istmo Ameghino Interpretation Centre. Travel on to Piramides Port, where you'll have the opportunity to join an optional navigation in small boats to see whales between June and December, or elephant seals or dolphins during the rest of the year.

Later, there is a stop in Caleta Valdes to allow you to have lunch and here you'll also see sea elephants. After lunch (own expense), you'll travel on to the southern portion of the Peninsula, known as Punta Delgada, where you'll see the elephant seals.

On the return journey, you'll travel past the Salinas and will have the chance to observe the terrestrial fauna. If you were unable to sail in the morning due to unsuitable weather conditions, you'll return past Piramides Port.

The Protected Natural Area of Punta Tombo hosts every year between September and April, the largest continental colony in the world of Magellanic Penguins. By the Atlantic Ocean shores, surrounded by farms dedicated to wool production, it is the place penguins choose for their reproduction. In front of the sea, half million penguins protect their nests from predators, look for food (little fish, anchovies and squids) for their offspring, fill the air with their squawks and paint the landscape in black and white. The best time to observe them is in the morning and at sunset, when it is not so hot and penguins increase their activities.

To reach Punta Tombo, it is necessary to drive about 180 kilometres towards the south from Puerto Madryn. The access route is mostly paved, but there are about 20 kilometres of gravel at the end of the road. At the entrance, the Centro Tombo provides various rooms where it is possible to learn more about the area's wildlife.

You'll depart from your hotel in the morning; we'll arrive into the reserve to walk near the nests. A big group of penguins on the beach can be observed from a cliff.

In the afternoon we'll return and stop in Trelew City ("Lewis town" in welsh language, Lewis Jones was one of the pioneers who came to these distant lands in the late nineteenth century). MEF E. Feruglio Paleontology Museum and visit (optional). Then continue to Gaiman Colony where the exquisite Welsh tea can be tasted (optional).

Arrival in Puerto Madryn late in the afternoon.

The train departs from End of the World station, by the same embankment that prisoners walked 100 years ago.

As you travel into Canadon del Toro, the train crosses Pipo River over "the burned bridge" where you can see old wooden bridge ruins under the new railroads. The train stops at La Macarena Cascade where you'll find a reconstruction of a typical settlement of the Yamanas, an indigenous group which inhabited these lands for hundreds of years.

The train will then enter Tierra del Fuego National Park following the Pipo River course and continue across areas that have traces left by the prisoners who, over half a century, travelled into the forest to cut trees as part of their daily routine. After skirting the Turbal, characteristic Tierra del Fuego soil on which Sphagnum moss grows, the train arrives at Park Station.

Throughout the tour you'll be accompanied by a bilingual guide who will explain in detail the history of the "Prisoners Train".

You'll enjoy a tour around one of the most important protected areas in the country and the only one which is located by the sea shore.

As you set off from the city centre you'll head south west and travel through coastal landscapes. After seeing the glacier valleys you will stop at the Southern Railway station, where you may choose to enter the Park on board the famous "End of the World Train" (own expense).

Upon arrival at the National Park you'll begin your tour of the different points of interest. At Bahia Ensenada the "Concheros Antropogenicos", remains of molluscs and ashes which are today covered with vegetation, are evidence of the native settlements which were in the area around 6,500 years ago.

You'll then head to Roca Lake where you can see the geography of Isla Grande de Tierra del Fuego. After walking through the park you'll have some free time and you may wish to taste some chocolate or coffee at Casita Del Bosque by the Lapataia River. From here you'll travel by bus or van, heading towards the outskirts of the city to appreciate the beautiful landscape.

After boarding the catamaran you'll set off from the tourist port along the coast of Ushuaia to view some of the most important buildings of the city including the Maritime Museum (former prison house), the End of the World Museum and the industrial area. From this vantage point the landscape combines sea and mountains. The mounts Olivia and Cinco Hermanos, Figue and Tunnel ranches, the craggy mounts and the Encajonado River can be seen.

Head towards the centre of the Beagle Channel, up to the Edeideurs lighthouse in the archipelago bearing the same name. On one of the islands you'll observe the remains of the Monte Cervantes ship which sank in 1930.

Continue on to Isla de los Lobos to appreciate the curious sea lions and then sail silently around the island for 20 minutes watching them in their habitat. The catamaran will then make its way to Isla de los Pajaros (Birds Island) in search of Magellan Cormorants, majestic Imperial Cormorants, albatrosses, Fullman petrels, giant petrels, squas and twenty different species of sea birds.

On your return to Ushuaia you'll sail through Paso Chico, with views of Monte Martial and the glacier.

This morning you will travel approximately 80 kilometres from El Calafate to the Perito Moreno Glacier, with the last 26 kilometres of your journey being within the Glaciers National Park.

From its beginning the trip offers pleasant surprises. On the outskirts of El Calafate, to your right you can see the Argentine Lake with its Round Bay, which is populated with an important variety of birds. You may observe the black-necked swan, flamenco, ducks, gallareta and cauquen, framed by the typical yellow of the countryside.

For the first 40 kilometres you will travel across the Patagonic steppe, to the entrance of the National Park. Observe the arboreal vegetation formed by nires, sour cherries, lengas and flowers of diverse colours. The outstanding "notro" has colourful red flowers and belongs in the Patagonic Andean Forest.

As you experience the majesty of the Perito Moreno Glacier, you will be amazed at the beauty of nature and the wild environment of your surroundings.

Walk along the different viewing platforms which offer good vantage points along the way. The ice wall rises 75 metres or more above the water and every now and again, you might even witness the glacier's cracking sounds from detaching icebergs. A spectacle not to be missed.

After this you will begin the Nautical Safari. This navigation of the Argentine Lake by the "Brazo Rico" allows you to appreciate the ice floes of the Perito Moreno Glacier.

Arriving at the South end of the channel of Ice floes, the boat will be located within a reasonable distance of the wall of the glacier. Travelling across its extension, you may witness any loosening that takes place.

Boarding will take place at the dock located in the Bay "Under the Shade", approximately 7 kilometres from the Viewpoint of the Glacier.

PERITO MORENO TOUR WITH MINITREK

A navigation in front of the South wall of the amazing Perito Moreno Glacier, a fantastic walk by a captivating forest and finally, the awe-inspiring mini-trek on the most famous glacier in Patagonia.

Your guided tour begins at the port located in the Bay "Under the Shade", approximately 6 km before the Viewpoint of the Glacier. You'll take a boat that crosses the "Brazo Rico" of the Argentine Lake, towards the channel of Ice floes and to the south wall of the Perito Moreno Glacier. After disembarking, the guide will split the group into mini groups of maximum 15 people for the mini-trek.

Your walk to the glacier begins by the border of the lake and will take approx. 20 minutes. Once you arrive at the edge of the icefield, the guide will show you how to put the crampons on and provide the pertinent instructions and demonstration. The trek on the Glacier lasts around 2 hours and you will appreciate the diversity of icicles, cracks, drains, small lagoons

and more. Explanations about flora, fauna and general "glaciology" of the region will be provided along the way. This walk is moderate in difficulty and the ice surface on which it takes place is irregular, but firm and safe.

When the trek ends, you'll continue walking through the "magallanico" forest and enjoy a visit to the Channel. Before returning to El Calafate, you'll be transferred to the glacier's viewing platforms where you'll spend approximately 1 hour. The ice wall rises 75 metres or more above the water and every now and again, you might even witness the glacier's cracking sounds from detaching icebergs. A spectacle not to be missed.

IMPORTANT:

- Physical Requirements: Please be aware that during this tour you will walk slowly for approximately 3 hours, on various landscapes including irregular ice, forest and "pedreros".
- Restrictions: due to the effort and difficulty involved on this tour, it is only suitable for people between 10 and 65 years. Overweight people cannot take this tour. Kindly note that overweight people are considered those that exceed this criteria: weight in kg. greater than twice the height in cm. minus 100 (e.g. 1.70 m height: 170 minus 100 = 70 x 2 = 140). Also not suitable for pregnant women; people with any degree or type of physical or mental disability that affects their attention or coordination; persons suffering central or peripheral cardiovascular diseases, using stents, pacemakers and other prostheses; (e.g. medicated with anticoagulants, varices grade III -thick and multiples-, cardiac arrhythmias), people suffering respiratory diseases (COPD, asthma, emphysema, etc.).
- Difficulty: Moderate to light.
- Footwear: Sport footwear or trekking shoes should be worn. It is advisable to wear thick socks, preferably wool or cotton. Rubber boots and high heeled shoes are not permitted. You'll only receive crampons.
- Clothing: It is recommended that you wear clothing that is suitable for physical activity including long trousers (no jeans), thermal or wool t-shirt and leggings, fleece jumper and waterproof jacket. It is advisable to also have a fleece beanie, gloves, sunglasses and sunscreen.
- Lunch: You must take your own boxed lunch, as there are no products to purchase after departure. Only the groups that take the excursion in the morning will have 40 minutes to have lunch in the refuge (Additional charge applies).
- Smoking: It is forbidden to smoke during the entire excursion, including on the boat, in the forest, on the ice or in the refuge.

If weather conditions permit it, one of the most privileged views of the area can be accessed by chairlift

Make your way to Estacion Central and take the train to Estacion Cataratas and/or Estacion Garganta del Diablo. From each location you'll have access to trails which offer views of the spectacular waterfalls.

- Garganta del Diablo: Departing from Estacion Cataratas, the train takes us to Estacion Garganta. The walk along the footbridges demands 1200 metres to delight us with the spectacular balcony of the most important waterfall of the Falls:

Time required for this ride: 2 hours

Difficulty range: low, no stairs

The Upper Circuit is an 800 metre trail which is raised above the ground's surface, so as not to block or scare away the local fauna. In this circuit, you will observe the waterfalls from the upper part of Dos Hermanas, Bosetti, Bernabe Mendez, and M'Bigua.

The Lower Circuit is a 1600 metre trail walk, also above the ground, with a view from the bottom of Dos Hermanas, Alvar Nunez, San Martin, Bosetti and Penon of Bella Vista waterfalls. From Penon you will view Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat) and Canon del Rio Iguazu inferior.
