


Grand Tour of Northern Italy

Florence



Chianti

Massa Carrara and Forte dei Marmi

Mantova

On the way to Verona, stop for lunch in Mantova, at one of the city's many trattorias and try some of the local specialties such as Risotto alla pilota or pasta with pumpkin. Mantova was the City of the Gonzaga family, one of the most important families in Italy during the Renaissance period. After lunch, visit Palazzo Te, a magnificent Renaissance palace that was the residence of the Gonzaga family. Head to Verona to check-in in at your hotel.

Verona

Morning dedicated to the visit of Verona. Free tour of the city center. The city shows its alternation of various dominations through its architecture: from the settlement of the Romans, to the age of commons, to the era of the Signoria of the Scaliger family until its Venetian and Habsburg dominations. Verona is the city of lovers and the place where Shakespeare set his most famous romantic drama of all time: Romeo and Juliet. Time at leisure and lunch on your own. In the afternoon, you can go inside the Giusti Garden, a private Italian-style Garden near the city center. Back to the hotel and dinner on your own.

Valpolicella and Padova

Check out the hotel. Head to the Valpolicella Valley, near Verona and the Lake Garda. You drive along the wine route of the Valpolicella and stop at one of the most important wineries of the area. Visit of the winery and wine-tasting experience (Amarone wine included). You will enjoy a cooking class and lunch. In the afternoon, check in at the hotel in Padova and time at leisure for the rest of the day.

Venice

Take a train to Venice (from Abano or Padua railway station). Once arrived at Venice, you will meet the local guide for a half-day visit of the city, a walk along the "Calli" (narrow streets), across the bridges and into the Campielli (little squares). After the visit, lunch on your own and time at leisure. Back to Padova. Dinner on your own.

Sirmione

Check-out and drive to Lake Garda, the biggest lake in Italy and check-in in the wonderful town of Sirmione. Sirmione is famous for its thermal water with it's healing properties. This town was made even more famous thanks to writers such as Catullo, Stendhal, Lawrence and Goethe that honored its artistic and environmental beauty.


Hotel in Milan City Center



Milan

The capital of Lombardy and Italy's second-largest city, Milan was an important trading center for more than two millennia, and once served as the capital of the western half of the Roman Empire. 
